Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: 8:05 pm

Approval of Minutes: Change to February Minutes to say \$20,212 was paid back to the Sartell Youth Rec Center under the Gambling Report. Motion to approve February 2007 Meeting Minutes, Bryan Bidinger. Second by Stacey Jurek. Motion passes.

Treasurer's Report: Mike Mundis – As of February we have \$17,055 in our checking account. Some lingering bills will come in March. \$62,000 has been paid to date for ice bills. Need to monitor ice times at all levels. Still auditing who has paid their dues for this year.

Gambling Report: Bryan Bidinger – \$18,638 deposited for February 2007, \$6,641 in expenses. Net profit for February after expenses and taxes is \$9,142. Motion to approve February by Bill Worzala. Second by Jon Pinkerton. Motion passes. Ending balance in checking account for the month of February was \$37,870. Received a refund of \$4,460 for unsold tickets for the calendar year. Pre-Approval expenses for April 2007 of \$12,750. Motion to accept by Mike Mundis, second by Bill Worzala. Motion passes. Motion was made to pay \$17,551 for the month of February to SYRC out of the gambling fund. Motion to approve by Mike Mundis. Second Dave Erickson. Motion carries. Possibility to put our pull-tabs at Howie's in St. Stephen which would include a \$150 license fee.

District 5 Report: Dave Erickson –

- 1) April meeting will be the last one for the year and includes a dinner. Plaques and medals will be handed out for the 1st & 2nd place in District play
- 2) Vote will be taken at the next meeting for the playoff request to have all teams go to D5 playoffs and not sending the #1 seed automatically.
- 3) Cold Spring brought up the fact that there are no guidelines written up on Mite Jamborees to follow and should be looked into. Sartell could be the host for next year.
- 4) Willmar may have the Bantam "A" Regional while Sartell should have the Bantam "B" Regional for 2008. Peewee "A" State tournament will be held in Willmar as well.
- 5) All Sartell Squirt teams received 90+ % fair play points and will be recognized for their achievement.
- 6) District 5 had approximately \$1200 in fines reported this year. \$325 was from our association which mostly resulted from late scores sheets. Suggestion was made to have teams pay for their own fees in future years.

Level Coordinator's Report:

IP: Alicia Dammen – Mite Jamborees are now over and IP has some remaining practices in the month of March. IP Committee will be looking to get some feedback again from the coaches for improvements that could be made to the current IP layout.

Squirts: Sheri Erickson – See “2006-2007 Squirts” attachment.

Girls: Phil Bachman – Twenty-four new girls at various levels were added to our association this year. U8 played a game in Litchfield and had a wonderful time. U12 recorded a 13-0-1 overall record in District play. Won their first 2 games at Regional's and lost their remaining games by one goal margins in each.

PeeWee: Mary Kay Lindmeier – PWC took 1st place in their District playoff bracket. PWB won their first District playoff game vs. Hutchinson and lost a close one to Crow River in the second round. PWA played River Lakes in the first round of their District playoffs and lost in overtime.

Bantam: Paul Orndorf – Bantam “A” played in Plymouth for Regional's and won their first game vs. Hopkins but came up short against Eden Prairie & Osseo. Bantam “B” played their games at the same place with losses to some very good teams like Wayzata, Eden Prairie & Blake. Overall, the Bantam teams had very successful year.

Old Business:

Tournament Update – For the season we hosted 4 tournaments. From the last 2 we gated over \$5,000 and concession sales have been very high. Thanks to all of you who volunteered your time during these tournaments.

New Business:

Mandatory April Meeting – Reminder that there is a mandatory meeting in April which voting will take place for new board members. Mike Mundis, Dave Erickson & Jon Pinkerton terms will be expiring this year. The Recreational Center has a couple openings on their board with terms expiring this year as well.

Referee Assignments – District 5 strongly recommends that associations go with outside services to schedule our referee's for games.

Coaching Survey – Mike Windshittl will be sending out a coaching survey since he will be taking over the Coaching Coordinator position next year. He will be contacting the Level Coordinators to pass along the surveys to their teams via e-mail.
