**Registration & Program Update**

- Winter Adult leagues are up and running with both The Minnesota Wild Adult League and the Adult Hockey Association (AHA).
- AHA currently has 109 teams in their Winter program and the Wild league has 143.
- AHA is currently running their Winter Beginner School with 33 new adult players on two teams.
- AHA Hockey is working to introduce programs to adult recreational players in the St. Cloud and Duluth areas. Plans are for late a Winter early Spring start in St. Cloud and Fall 2010 for Duluth.
- USAH cancelled the planned Adult Hockey Skills Clinic at the National Sports Center which would have run October 2-4, 2009 due to lack of interest.

**Tournaments & Events**

- AHA Hockey is working to develop a Recreational Hockey Festival combining ice hockey with alpine skiing activities. Plans are to hold the first event in Vail Colorado, Winter 2011. As previously stated, the USA Hockey Adult Council in June, 2009 declined to endorse and participate in the development of this event.
- The National Sports Center is working with USAH in hopes of hosting a Classic tournament at the Schwan Super Rink.

**Other News**

- Registration for AHA's Spring Beginner and Summer League programs will open in February and March. Both programs are sanctioned.
