MRC Policy 021998.1 – CHILD INFORMATION PROTECTION

CHILD INFORMATION PROTECTION: All personal information collected on a minor is to remain strictly confidential. No committees or individual may disclose any personal information to any organization or individual without the approval of the Executive Board or the appropriate Sport Commissioner. Any members who have been given approval to possess personal information (such as medical release forms, ratings, registration forms, etc) must keep the information confidential and return the information to the appropriate MRC officials upon completion of the approved purpose.

Under no circumstances is a minor's full name or a photograph of a minor to be printed in any public forum (including but not limited to newspapers, newsletters, websites, social networks and mass mailings) without the express written consent of the minor's parent or legal guardian.

EXCEPTIONS – There are no exceptions.

REASON – This policy is for the protection of and to ensure the privacy of all minors who participate in MRC sports and activities.
