# **HGBA Scholarship Nomination Form**

The Board of Directors of Hingham Girls Basketball ("HGBA") may elect to award one (1) annual scholarship to one or more 12th grade Hingham High School female who has been involved with HGBA (including the Hingham High School basketball program) and whose high school record displays academic excellence, community service, leadership, and commitment to HGBA. A nomination form, available via download from the HGBA website, must be completed and submitted each year by email or postal mail, to the President of HGBA by April 1<sup>st</sup> of the calendar year; no nominations will be accepted after this deadline.

### **Eligibility**

Any 12<sup>th</sup> grade Hingham High School female who has been involved with HGBA (including the Hingham High School basketball program) is eligible to be nominated for this scholarship. Daughters of the officers who make up the voting body of HGBA are not eligible, unless those officers recuse themselves of any voting privileges related to the award of this scholarship.

#### Voting

Voting to award a scholarship will be restricted to members of the HGBA Board. Only written nominations submitted before the deadline will be considered. Each year, the HGBA Board will determine the dollar value of the scholarship and the number of scholarships to award; if multiple scholarships are awarded in any year, the dollar value of each scholarship shall be the same. The HGBA Board may elect to award no scholarships in any calendar year. HGBA Board members may vote for more than one nominee.

#### **Notification of Award**

The Scholarship Award Certificate and the monetary award will be presented to the recipient(s) at the Senior Awards Banquet. Letters of Notification of Award will be sent directly to the Hingham High School Principal, Guidance Office, Athletic Director, directly to the awardee, and to the Hingham Journal.
