

## Phoenixville Area Soccer Club Coaches Code of Conduct

We at PASC believe that soccer should be a fun, educational, and positive experience for all players, coaches, parents, and spectators. We believe that everyone who coaches within PASC is, first and foremost, a teacher of the game with a duty to ensure he or she is coaching with and exhibiting the highest sportsmanship and ethical values.

- **1. Trustworthiness.** I will be worthy of trust in all I do and teach players the importance of integrity, honesty, reliability, and loyalty.
- **2. Respect.** I will treat all people (parents, coaches, players, opponents, officials) with respect at all times and will require the same of my players.
- **3. Class.** I will be a good sport, teach and model good behavior, be gracious in victory and dignified in defeat, encourage players to give fallen opponents a hand, compliment extraordinary performance, and show sincere respect in pre- and post- game rituals.
- **4. Referees.** I will treat referees with respect. I will not complain about or argue with referee calls or decisions during or after a game. I will use PASC or league approved methods for reporting referee issues to the proper authority, and I will require the same of my players and spectators.
- **5. Coaching.** I will use positive coaching methods to make every player's experience enjoyable, increase self-esteem, and foster a love for and appreciation of the sport. I will refrain from physical or psychological intimidation, verbal abuse, and conduct that is demeaning to the players or others.
- **6. Effort and Teamwork.** I will encourage players to pursue victory with honor, to think and play as a team, to do their best and continually strive to improve through personal effort and discipline. I will discourage selfishness and put less emphasis on the final outcome of the contest than upon effort, teamwork, and competing with character.
- **7. Role Model.** I will be a worthy role model, be always mindful of the high visibility and great influence I have as a coach, and consistently conduct myself in a manner that exemplifies the traits I wish to develop in my players.
- **8. Personal Conduct.** I will refrain from profanity, disrespectful conduct, and the use of alcohol and tobacco in front of the players.
- **9. Competence.** I will strive to improve my coaching competence, acquire increased proficiency in coaching principles appropriate for my team's age group, and to whatever degree possible, seek certification and training as a coach.
- **10. Knowledge of the Rules.** I will maintain a thorough knowledge of current game and competition rules and will ensure that my players know and understand the rules.

- **11. Integrity of the Game.** I will protect the integrity of the game, teaching and playing the game according to the rules.
- **12. Safe Competition.** I will put safety and health considerations above a desire to win. I will never permit players to intentionally injure another player or engage in reckless play that might cause injury to themselves or others.
- **13. Concussion Awareness.** I will comply with the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association, state of Pennsylvania, and PASC regulations and complete the required concussion training certification before the start of the soccer season.
- **14.** Background Check. I will voluntarily submit to a background check to verify that I have no history or record of abuse or misconduct.

I have read and understand the requirements of this Code of Conduct. I will act in accordance with this code. I understand that club officials will and should expect me to follow this code and have the right to dismiss me if I do not.
