Policy/Procedure: Players Playing at a Higher Level – Policy S



The Amery Youth Hockey Association does not permit players to play at a higher age level based upon Wisconsin Amateur Hockey Association policy except under the following conditions:

- All high school players attending a school within the WIAA district may try out for the WIAA High School team; however, if they are not selected to play on the WIAA High School team and have remaining Bantam level eligibility, they must play at the Bantam level.
- Goalies may be allowed to “play up” at a higher level with the approval of their parents/guardians, the board splitting committee and the hockey board of directors IF the board believes it is in the best interest of the association to permit this movement.
- No other players within AYHA will be allowed to play above the WAHA age level for which they are eligible. However, players may be allowed to double roster at the next higher level up based on demonstrated and board approved needs. The player’s primary team will be their age specific team. This movement must be approved by both level coaches, parents, and the board.
