

# Outdoor League Rules

Number of allowed players on the field by division

- U10 = 8 v 8
- U11 = 9 v 9
- U12 = 9 v 9
- U13 = 11 v 11
- U14 = 11 v 11

Time of play for each division

- 25 minute halves and 5 minute halftimes

Penalties that will apply to irresponsible coaches, players, or team officials.

- Coach & Team officials – Ejection from game, written detailed description of incident should go in referee game report. A one game suspension from the team they were coaching when penalized.
  - Could be more than one game suspension if circumstances warrant it. That will be a RSSC rules committee decision.
- Player – Ejection from the game, written detailed description of incident should go in the referee game report. A one game suspension from the team playing on when penalized.
  - Could be more than one game if the circumstances warrant but that will be a RSSC rules committee decision.
- Team - If a player is sent off the team plays down a player the remainder of that game.

Each coach is responsible for controlling the fans of his or her team

Certified rosters will be required at each game

Center referee will submit game reports to Frankie at [risingstarssportscenter@gmail.com](mailto:risingstarssportscenter@gmail.com) by the end of the day that the game was played

All players must have a player pass or they will be unable to participate in the game

No league administrators will attend matches

Frank Conestabile Jr is the primary contact, (315)-335-1811 if goals are not anchored down, flags in place, or lines not marked

In case of injuries the coach, players, parents, and/or 911 should take the proper steps in providing care

The protocols RSSC will take in an emergency situation will be to contact 911

If a game is cancelled Frank Jr will notify the referees and impacted coaches immediately upon learning about the cancellations.

Each coach will be responsible for providing one qualified lines person

The time each team should show up to a game is the decision the coach and parents agree on, but 15 minutes is recommended

The referee and coaches will make the decision to stop or continue a game due to potentially hazardous weather or field conditions. If the two coaches don't agree then the referee has the final authorization to make the call
