Welcome Statement

Discussed Idea of placing fall and spring meetings either in a more central location or rotating the meetings among member associations. Breck offered to host the fall meeting.

Scott implored all associations considering creating a tier II team to be inclusive of other associations and the players in those associations who have the ability and interest in competing at that level.

Discussion of more jamboree style weekends to accommodate less travel weekends. This opens up the schedule as well as curtails the amount of travel necessary.

Double roster:

Rule was changed at the spring meeting. Compliance was discussed as well as punitive ideas for coaches not following the rule. Scott asked all members to brainstorm ideas to clarify and simplify this rule. Asked for ideas surrounding the breaking of this rule.

State Championship:

Membership was in agreement that they felt the State Championship idea was not a good fit for the MSGHL. We have the most comprehensive (and only) league for girls hockey. If the teams that are not interested in joining the MSGHL then they will have to find other ways to establish their credibility. A big concern would be the exclusion of New Mexico in the tournament.

Scott asked that dialogue be started amongst associations to help determine the best way to grow girls hockey across the state, especially at the lower levels. Growth ideas were also considered in creating a divisional format to curtail travel. Try it free programs, bring a friend programs, etc.

Tournament information needs to get to Scott Harris as soon as possible for addition to the MSGHL Website.

League championship tournament will continue to be held at the Edge. Consistent weekends with a 3 year contract.
