

Travel to Canada (via air or land) – MN Blades

Please read carefully for travel to Canada.....we don't want anyone to miss out!

Via Air –

- When entering Canada from United States, anyone 16 & older needs a Driver's License and proof of U.S. citizenship (such as a U.S. birth certificate, naturalization certificate, or expired U.S. passport). Children under sixteen need only present proof of U.S. citizenship.

BUT.....

- When returning to the United States from Canada, it is very important to note that **all** U.S. citizens are required to present a valid U.S. passport to re-enter the United States.

Via Land or Sea –

- When entering Canada from United States, anyone 16 & older needs a Driver's License and proof of U.S. citizenship (such as a U.S. birth certificate, naturalization certificate, or expired U.S. passport). Children under sixteen need only present proof of U.S. citizenship.

BUT.....

- Effective June 1, 2009, when returning to the United States from Canada, anyone 16 or older needs a passport to re-enter the United States from Canada. Travelers under 16 can still use proof of citizenship (original or photocopy of birth certificate).

Child traveling with one parent or with another family-

- If a child is traveling with only one parent, they must have a letter of consent from the other parent given them permission to take the child out of the country. The letter needs to be **NOTARIZED**. Your bank will do it for free....I know US Bank does.
- If you plan to travel to Canada with a minor who is not your own child or for whom you do not have full legal custody, a notarized letter of consent, from the minor's parents or legal guardians, is also necessary.

Below is a sample of a consent letter if only parent is traveling with child. Do not sign the letter until you are in front of the notary.
