Minutes from September 9, 2014

MOTION: Cindy Holguin made a motion to approve the September 9, 2014, minutes. Danielle Bowers seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

The current available balance is \$14,000 in the main account, and \$9,000 in the raffle account. The outstanding checks total is \$25,000.

Old Business:

- **Early Bird Tournament Wrap Up:** 29 teams participated in the tournament playing a total of 61 games. Three Arapahoe teams played in the championship games. Games ran on time. Only final scores were entered into Sport NGIN because not all rosters were available in the electronic scoring system. All Arapahoe teams met their required volunteer hours.
- **Zoola Rewards Fundraising:** Zoola Rewards is a cash back loyalty rewards program. Register your credit card through Zoolarewards.com/ayhl, shop at participating businesses listed on the Zoola website, and earn cash for your hockey team.
- **Snapbooster Texting Fundraising:** The Booster Club program code is **AIWH**. With all teams using the same code, the amount of money from SnapBooster should increase compared to last year. The Booster Club will distribute this money to the participating teams.

- **Booster Club Player Scholarship Deadline:** October 15, 2014

New Business:

- **CCYHL:** CAHA announced the Recreational Travel State Championship tournament dates, February 20 – March 8, 2015. These dates conflict with the CCYHL League schedule, so CCYHL teams will not participate. CCYHL will still have league playoffs for both the President and Governor's divisions. For the President's division, the first place team in the league standings, and the CCYHL championship team will advance to the Federation Cup to play against CDYHL teams.

Home teams are responsible for game warm up pucks. The tiering meeting for the President and Governor's divisions is scheduled for November 24, 2014. All divisions, with the exception of Bantam AA, Midget Minor AA, and Midget Major AA, will be tiered based on the results of the first six games played by each team.

Midget AA against Tier I teams: 15 minute periods for home games, 17 minute periods for away games.

- **Team Jersey Rental Payment:** Teams are to write their checks payable to Player's Bench, \$90 per player, and give their checks to Hank Taylor.
- Tiffany Peil discussed a fundraising opportunity for teams. It is a fundraising ap through the company Relevant Solutions. The cost is \$20 per subscription, and 70% of the \$20 goes back to the organization. In return, the buyer receives mobile coupon deals.
- Sport NGIN scoring issues were discussed.
- The Safesport meeting for head coaches and team managers is scheduled for October 27, 2014 from 6:30 pm – 8:30 pm.
- Final season payment is due on October 31, 2014. The ice office will send out a reminder.
- DU night for Arapahoe is on the AYHL website
