Greetings

Sec/Tres: Accounting is in order all but 2 associations have paid their league fees. Karl will send out reminder invoices next week to those associations. Bill pay for accounts such as Sport Ngin are all current.

Comms:

Scheduling Director: Shaun Hathaway address the concerns about Sport Ngin. Concerns about Associations granting to many permissions to individuals and suggested that no more than 2 representatives from each team/association be given these permissions. Each association should have a single contact whom administers this. Shaun will follow up later with a letter to all making some recommendations.

Albert from New Mexico address some concerns about Sport Ngin and it was determined that the problems were related to where scoring was done. Shaun stated that ALL scoring must be done through the CAHA site and not an associations independent sites.

Discussion on Double Rostering changes getting updated into League Rules. Also addressed the 50% eligibility rule for players no matter what league they play in. Jeff was concerned about and Injured player eligibility but was reassured about a case by case determination if a player comes up short by the end of season. GJ from Gunnison also asking about eligibility for girls playing in 2 separate leagues (Boys/Girls) and the eligibility requirements. ?CAHA Rep Randy? Re confirmed that they must meet each leagues eligibility requirements which is 50% (MSGHL, CDYHL).

Jeff asked that all coaches/managers please submit DBL Roster players be submitted in writing (email) to him prior to the weekend games with Player Names and Teams that they are rostered on until a better solution for verifying is in place.

Discussion on player eligibility for CAHA State Tournament with regards to players who have played on Tier I & II teams are not eligible for being rostered on a Recreational (A) team. In affect they are only eligible for Tier play only. CAHA rep reconfirmed.

Request that Tournament structure be discussed at the December meeting.

Discussion about U10 exhibition game at the League Championships encourage involvement from other associations other than just Vail and Aspen. Suggestion was made to create composite teams representing more associations. This would allow association who have small numbers to be able to participate and foster growth in girls hockey.
