## 2015 GIRLS PLAYER DEVELOPMENT CAMP

**Thursday, March 12th through Saturday, March 14th at Arcadia Ice Arena**

The Arizona Girls Player Development Camp is open to all girls who are members of USA Hockey and born in the following birth years; 1998/1999 (17/16); 2000 (15) and 2001 (14). Under USA Hockey guidelines, Girls must be US Citizens and residents of the State of Arizona in these birth years in order to be eligible to be chosen as an Arizona representative for advancement to the new Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp. This year's Arizona Camp will have three (3) ice slots encompassing power skating, skills development and skills/scrimmages sessions. Goalies will also receive a two hour goalies only session, combined with boys goalies, on Wednesday, March 11<sup>th</sup> at Oceanside Ice Arena.

The primary focus of the camp is skills and fundamentals development of the individual player. The Camp also serves as an evaluation and selection process of players in three age groups, 2001's, 2000's and 1999's/1998's combined, to represent the State of Arizona at the Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp. The Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp replaces the Rocky Mountain Girls Player Development Camp of past years. The Multi-District Camp will combine girls from the Rocky Mountain District, the Pacific District and the Northern Plains District at one Camp on the campus of Colorado College in Colorado Springs, Colorado. The dates of the 2015 Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp are June 13 – 18. . Players will live in dorms with the coaching staff for training and education and will be similar in structure to a USA Hockey National Camp. Girls with birth years of 1998, 1999 and 2000 will also be evaluated for the opportunity to advance to USA Hockey's National Player Development Camps in their respective age divisions later in the summer. Additional information about the Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp will be available shortly and emailed to all as well as posted to the AAHA website .

As has been the case for the past several years, Arizona will be bringing in two outside evaluators, Mallory Michaels, Head Women's Hockey Coach for Colby College, and Christa Talbot, Head Women's Hockey Coach for Williston Northampton Prep, to serve as coaches/evaluators for the Camp. Together, they will be responsible for the on-ice skill development and scrimmage sessions as well as the selection of girls to advance to the Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp.

**The cost of the 2015 Arizona Girls Player Development Camp is \$135.00 per Player thru March 8<sup>th</sup>, \$145.00 after March 8<sup>th</sup>.**

*Players selected to attend the Girls Multi-District Player Development Camp will be responsible for paying an additional fee of \$650 for the camp which will include the player's room and board. Players selected will be notified of registration and payment procedures by the District.*  
*The Arizona allocations, as received from the District, for the Joint Camp are: 4 forwards, 2 defensemen and 1 goalie per age division.*
