Timbergrove Sports Association Baseball Bat Rules

TSA is committed to player safety and strives for consistency, where possible, with other national leagues such as USSSA, Nations, Pony and Little League. To that end, bats in violation of the below specifications will not be allowed at TSA games or practice.

1. TSA allows bats up to 2 ¾ inches in diameter. 2 ¼”, 2 5/8” and 2 ¾” are all legal sizes. Wood bats are allowed. Dented or altered bats are illegal. Specific bat rules will differ by division, as detailed below.
2. All bats used in Pinto thru Pony must have the “USSSA BPF 1.15” stamp imprinted on the bat. The “BBCOR” stamp commonly used for High School bats will also be allowed.
3. Shetland: Only bats specifically stamped for “T-ball” will be allowed in play.
4. Pinto: While lighter bats are recommended for the typically young players, the max allowable drop (difference between length and weight) is “-14”. For example, a player wishing to use a 27” bat must ensure the weight of the bat is 13oz or greater. Coach Pitch or Youth bats are allowed, provided they meet with the regulations listed in this section.
5. Mustang and Bronco: The max allowable drop (difference between length and weight) is “-12”. For example, a player wishing to use a 27” bat must ensure the weight of the bat is 15oz or greater.
6. Pony: The max allowable drop (difference between length and weight) is “-10”. For example, a player wishing to use a 27” bat must ensure the weight of the bat is 17oz or greater.
