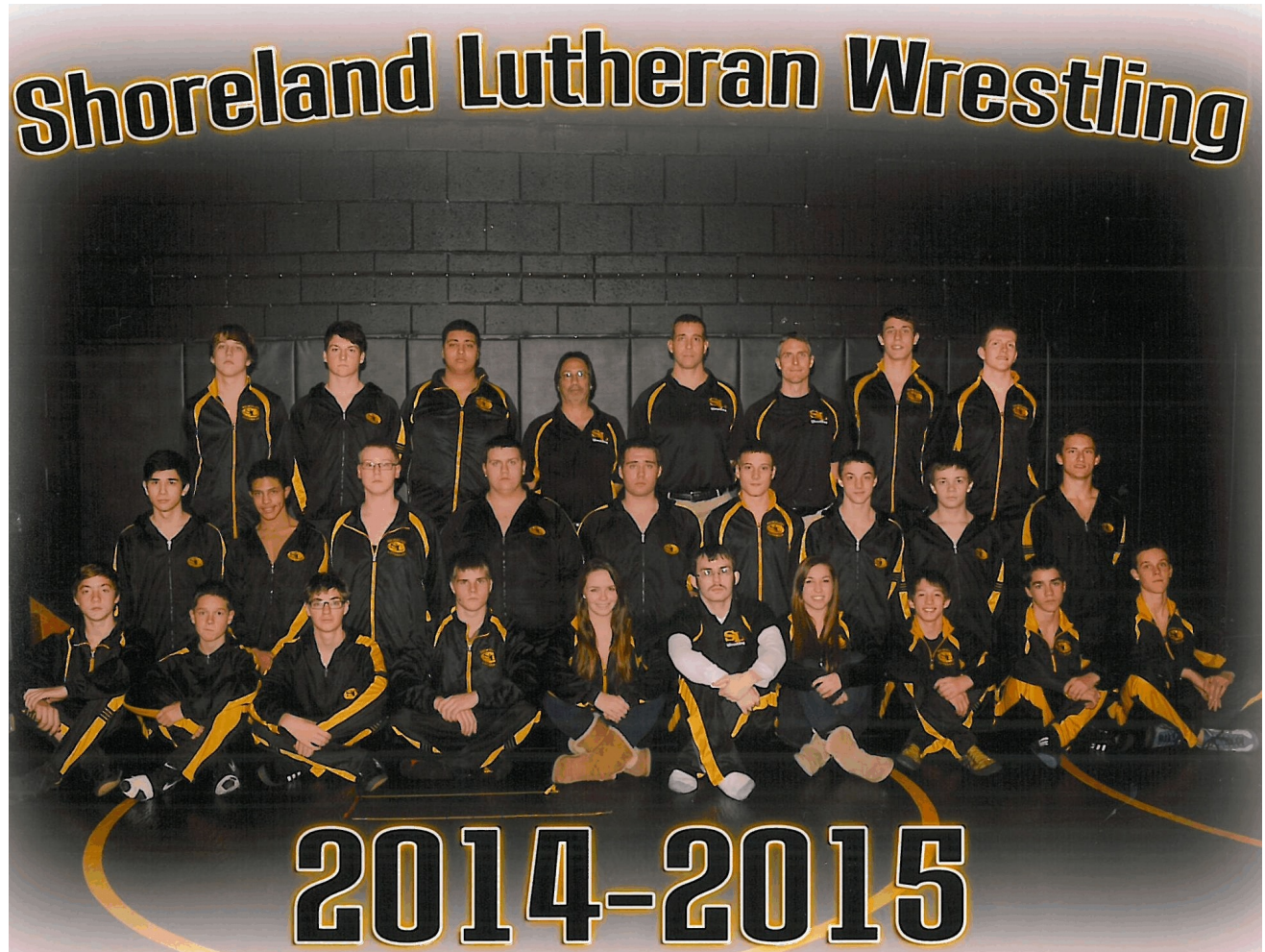

She was always willing and ready to help and also took care of our weights and stuff.

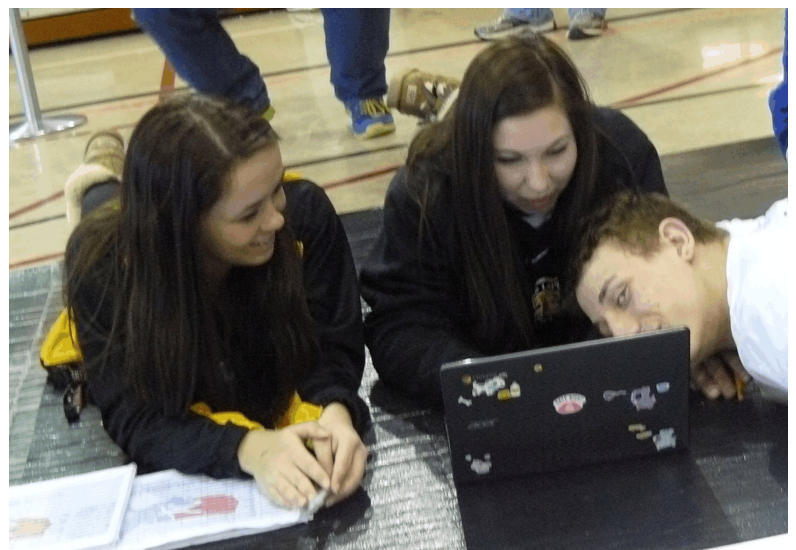
Her good attitude.
