Game Procedures

We will make every effort to keep the games running on time. The referees and field marshals will be instructed to make sure games start on time. All games will end no later than five minutes prior to the starting time of the next scheduled game. Therefore there will be no pre-game warm-ups on the field. We ask that after the game, please vacate the bench area as soon as possible to allow the next team fast access to the benches.

At the beginning of each game, the player passes will be collected by the field marshal.

Be sure to verify the final score at the end of the game on the game card.

Parents and spectators are required to sit on the side of the field opposite of the players. No one may sit with the players with the exception of the licensed coaches.

Field Marshals

The Schaumburg Soccer Fest uses a system of Field Marshals to insure the games are on time, as a resource in case of a problem, and as a first line of communication. There will be a Field Marshal assigned to each field who will have radio communication to medical personnel if needed. It is advised that when you arrive at your field for your game, that you find your Field Marshal to go through necessary pre-game steps as soon as possible. This will help us keep the Tournament running smooth and on time.
