

Twin City Figure Skating Association "Champion for Skating Winter Olympiad Award"

The purpose of this award is to recognize the efforts of those volunteers who share their time and talents with the sport of figure skating on a local, regional, and/or national level. These volunteers specifically help to promote, support, encourage and foster the sport of figure skating among all Twin Cities clubs and throughout the Twin Cities area. This award will be presented every 4-year beginning with 2022 and every four (4) years thereafter.

- A. Volunteer.
- B. Directly or indirectly involved with own club, Twin City Figure Skating Association or any other figure-skating associated activity for a *minimum* of five years.
- C. Resident of Minnesota.

II. Specific criteria for "The Champion for Skating Winter Olympiad Award"

- A. Both "high visibility" involvement and sustained "low profile" support of figure skating will be considered in selection.
- B. Specific volunteer characteristics to be considered are:
 - 1. Time devoted.
 - 2. Talents contributed.
 - 3. Demonstrated leadership.
 - 4. Spirit of cooperation fostered.

III. Selection Process

- A. Nominations are open to all TCFSA-member club members although the nominated person need not be from same club as the nominator.
- B. The nomination form will be given to TCFSA delegates to distribute to their club members.
- C. Forms will be distributed at the April meeting and will be due to the Selection Committee by August 15th of the same year.
- D. Selection Committee will be made up of the TCFSA Executive Board. The 1st Vice President will be chair of the committee.
