

The Bette Snuggerud Scholastic and Skating Award
The James Disbrow Scholastic and Skating Award

Dear Minnesota State Competitor:

The Bette Snuggerud Scholastic and Skating Award and The James Disbrow Scholastic and Skating Award will be awarded based on a combination of the total of the judges marks received and the GPA of the candidate's previous school year. If you meet all of the requirements listed below, we encourage you to become a candidate. If you are chosen, you will be notified within two days of the close of the competition. You and a guest will then be invited by the Twin City Figure Skating Association to the Official's Dinner in September to receive your award.

Requirements for the Snuggerud and Disbrow Awards:

*Candidate must be a Senior level lady (Snuggerud Award) or any level male skater (Disbrow Award) who is currently a 10th, 11th, or 12th grade full time high school or a full time college student enrolled in a fully accredited school, attending classes and carrying the minimum number credit hours necessary to be a full-time student.

*In year previous to competition, candidate must have been a full-time high school (9th-12th grade) or a full-time college student enrolled in a fully accredited school, attending classes and carrying the minimum number of credit hours necessary to be a full-time student.

*Must provide the Chief Accountant with a sealed, official, certified copy of your transcript from your high school or college which includes all grades from the previous school year.

*Transcript must be either postmarked no later than August 15 or brought to the Accounting Room during the competition. (Note: Only the Chief Accountant and the Chief Referee will review transcripts)
