CHS Softball Varsity Lettering Guidelines

A student/athlete may earn a Varsity letter if she:

- ❖ Remains a member of the team, in good standing, for the entire season. Any player who quits the team or who is otherwise removed from the team at any point during the season will not be eligible to receive a letter (this includes violations of MSHSL or CHS rules).
- ❖ Plays in 9 Varsity games or
 - Has at least 30 varsity at bats
 - Impacts the program in a positive way and/or joins the team because of specific need (ex: injury to teammate - last two weeks of season) - HC has final say – judgment call
- ❖ Is a player who has been making a significant contribution, but sustains a softball - related injury which prohibits further competition, provided she continues to attend practices and games and assist in managerial duties.
- ❖ Represents the program in a positive light, supports all levels of teams with-in the program (JV & C squad) and respects all coaches. - HC has final say – judgment call
- ❖ Meets or exceeds expectations set forth by our coaching staff and the Minnesota State High School League
- ❖ Coach Buchmann reserves the right to letter athletes that meets all expectations and demonstrate the passion for the Program. (i.e Managers, injured players,etc..)

Note: Special cases that are not included above will be determined on an individual basis by the coaching staff. If a player receives a chemical violation, she will not letter.
