## Entertainment Team Expectations & Requirements ~ Skater & Parent

To participate on a MSLFSC Entertain Team:

1. Skater must be a full club member of MSLFSC.
2. Skater must be in level Basic 8, Free Skate 1 through 6 or Beyond the Basics.
3. Skater must be enrolled in a Learn to Skate, Free Skate or Beyond the Basics class.
4. If the skater is not enrolled in a Learn to Skate, Free Skate or Beyond the Basics class, an additional \$50.00 per skater per season will be required to participate on an Entertainment Team.
5. Skater will attend all practices, special performances and ice show performances. Any missed practice needs to be reported to the designated coach prior to practice.
6. Skater must be in good standing with MSLFSC, which is defined as: all club fees and coaching fees must be current and the skater will have no athletic code of conduct violations.
7. Parent(s) will donate 3 to 5 hours of volunteer time for entertainment team needs. This is in addition to the club required volunteer hours.
8. Parents will fulfill their 3 to 5 hours of required volunteer time assembling props and other tasks as assigned by the Entertainment Team Leader\*.
9. Parent(s) will help with Entertainment Team needs at special performance(s) (Badger State Games) and the annual MSLFSC Ice Show in March.
10. Parent(s) must be willing to become an Entertainment Team Leader, by either volunteering or assignment.
  - The Entertainment Team Leader will be responsible for assigning tasks to parents related to prop needs for the team.
  - The Entertainment Team Leader will track the volunteer hours of other parents as it pertains to the Entertainment Team.
  - The Entertainment Team Leader will receive volunteer hour credits for all above work.
