Action report (Debbie Morton)

- 1. Promotion/relegation
- A. Rising U-14, relegate bottom team from east and west with the association promotions from second division
- B. For U-14 age, men and women, there will be promotion and relegation at end of fall season.
- 2. U-15 women playing Region III Premier League will be granted the option to not play both NCYSA classic league regular season and Region III Premier League.
- 3. The U-14 men and women playing Region III Premier League will not be allowed to opt out of playing NCYSA classic regular season play.
- 4. Rescheduling
 - A. Teams will be given the option to initiate one rescheduled match per season (using the new 2-part rescheduling form), since they have a preseason scheduling meeting
- 5. U-11 teams entering mid-season will have non-reporting/non-counting matches, and U-12 thru U-14 teams will be given counting games and will have the opportunity for promotion and relegation.
- 6. For modified fields (U11-U12 small-sided) there will be a 6:1 ratio. There will no longer be a two-field minimum for the full size 6:1 ratio requirement.
