PeeWee Jamboree – no more teams to commit. Confirmed, Princeton, BBL, Andover, Monticello. Need 16 teams. All level A. \$700, 4 Games.

**Board Member Reports:**

Ace Coordinator - It is in the works to find the right person for this position.

Equipment manager – We received 8 sets of gear from Total Hockey. Cards will be given to new mini mites to pick up equipment at total hockey.

Fundraising – everything was handed out at registration.

Girls Coordinator – we will be co-oping with Elk River at this level; ice will be split 50/50 between arenas. Currently will not have 12U team, all families have been told they would need to play youth. We will have a 10U team. Working with Chris Papesch to see if we can find a solution for the 12U's. Continue to discuss the 12U team...trying to recruit additional girls that have not yet registered.

Mite Coordinator – Sarah Stang will take over this position.

Recruiting –Shopper flyer will run again this year.
