The hockey club at California University of Pennsylvania has been in existence for many years, but its past history is certainly not one of great success and accomplishment. In 2002, however, that legacy was broken. That year, Jamison Roth teamed with advisor Chuck Bohn to breathe life into the forgettable program. What has happened since has been a rise to excellence that has placed Cal U among the top hockey programs in the region and nation. The future promises a bright future for Cal U Hockey.

Cal U joined the College Hockey East (CHE) for the 2002-03 season and immediately established itself as a team to be reckoned with by winning the 2003 CHE Provisional Tournament Championship. That same year, Cal U joined the American Collegiate Hockey Association (ACHA) at the Division III level. The CAL-I team is still a member of CHE and ACHA today. The CHE currently consists of teams from western Pennsylvania and western New York, while the ACHA DIII level is approximately 140 teams from colleges and universities across the nation. Cal U won seven consecutive CHE titles (07,08,09,10,11,12,13) before losing this past season to Pitt-Johnstown. The program also won the University's first ever male national team championship, as the Vulcan's won the 2008 ACHA Division III National Championship. The ACHA holds its annual national tournament every March at various locations across the country. California University of PA hosted the 2005 ACHA DIII National Championships in Pittsburgh where the team finished 7th overall.

Hosting the 2005 National Tournament in Pittsburgh went a long way in strengthening the relationship the hockey club has with the University. While the team is unable to provide scholarships to its players, the University does provide the team with the financial and academic support it needs to operate effectively. The club is still run by the players, who pay dues each semester and form a Board of Directors to oversee its operations.

After starting the 2002 season with only 12 players, the Cal Hockey Club has grown to over 60 men players strong, warranting the formation of a second men's team. The Collegiate Hockey Association (CHA) was formed in 2004 with Cal U's second team as one of four founding members. The purpose of the CAL-II team is to provide another level of play for Cal's hockey players that isn't quite as competitive and doesn't require quite the same time commitment as the CHE team. That doesn't mean the CHA team is just an afterthought, though, proven by its run to the CHA Championship Games in 2005 & 2010 and first ever CHA Championship in 2012. Starting last season the CAL-II team joined the CIHA (Collegiate Ice Hockey Association) where the team now has the opportunity to play for a National Championship every season.

The 2008-09 season marked the inaugural season of our women's program. The team accomplished unprecedented success in its first season by winning its regular season and playoff conference championships. In winning the regular season crown, the team finished with a perfect 10-0-0 conference record. The women participate in the Delaware Valley College Hockey Conference (DVCHC) and nationally in the ACHA Women's Division II. The women's team has now won a DVCHC Division II Championship in 2009 and the DVCHC Division I Championship in 2011. In the 2013-14 season the Vulcans joined the College Hockey East's Women Division along with Penn State, West Chester and Delaware. In the inaugural season the Vulcans won the leagues first every championship on their way to a third straight ACHA National Tournament appearance.

As the fourth largest indoor ice arena in Western Pennsylvania the Rostraver Ice Garden opened in 1965. It has been a home to numerous organizations over the years including the practice facility for the Pittsburgh Penguins. Currently it also serves as the home ice for the Mon Valley Thunder, Ringgold High School, Frazier High School, Elizabeth Forward High School and Serra Catholic High School.



Hockey has not been the only sport that has taken place inside the Ice Garden as professional boxing, wrestling, arena football and bull riding also have over the years. Other events have included concerts, circuses, comedy shows and at one time the site of the Westmoreland County Fair. Although, the Ice Gardens claim to fame may come from when former professional boxer Cassius Clay fought there during his amateur career.

Another amenity to the Rostraver Ice Garden is Murph's Pub, which is a restaurant and lounge located on the second level of the Ice Garden. Fans will have the opportunity to watch games from Murph's Pub as it overlooks the entire ice surface.



Geraldine M. Jones – Acting President



On May 16, 2012, Geraldine Jones was named acting president of California University of Pennsylvania.

Ms. Jones graduated from California State College in 1972 and earned her master's degree at California in 1980.

She began her career in education as a second-grade teacher in the Albert Gallatin School District, in Uniontown, PA.

She returned to California in 1974, serving as program director for Upward Bound for 20 years and as chair of the Department of Academic Development Services for 11 years. She was associate dean of the College of Education and Human Services for two years before serving as dean from 2000-2008.

In July 2008, she was named provost and vice president for academic affairs, positions she held until being appointed as acting University President.

A member of the Cal U Alumni Association board of directors, Jones has received numerous honors, including the Cal U Alumni Association's John R. Gregg Award for Loyalty and Service, the Black Alumni Association's Outstanding Service Award, and the Community Service Award given by the Minority Students Association at Penn State Fayette.

In 2010 Jones was one of 50 'Women of Excellence' honored by the New Pittsburgh Courier, one of the oldest and most prestigious black newspapers in the United States.

Jones is a lifelong member of Mt. Zion AME Church of Brownsville, Pa., where she has been the church pianist since age 14. She has been married to Jeffrey B. Jones for 38 years; they have two adult daughters and a granddaughter.

Vulcans Ready to Hit The Ice For The 2014-15 Season

Cal looks to regain their CHE Crown and head back to the National Tournament

Excitement is around the Cal U hockey team as they begin the 2014-15 season.

The Vulcans will look to win yet another Kaliena Cup and regain their CHE crown all on their way to a fifth straight ACHA National Tournament appearance.

This season the Vulcans return three ACHA All-Atlantic Region players including the Atlantic Region Player of the Year, Dan Bailey, along with Atlantic Region Coach of the Year Justin Berger.

Overall the team will return 13 players from last year's team that went 24-4.

While the Vulcans return a number of veterans from a season ago they must also replace 12 key contributors.

Lost are Jeremy Pell, Mitch Fernandez, Mike Marconi, Tim Gleason, Tom Graw, Zach Stewart, Neil Stewart, Ryan Abbott, Chad Gwynn, Tony DiBiccaro, Tim Mooney and Neil Isler.

Gleason, Fernandez and Stewart were all named to the ACHA Atlantic All Region team last season.

Along with Bailey, the Vulcans return key contributors Boyd

Zinger, Brad Mitchell, Mike Warner and John Miller along with bringing back Justin Locante.

Zinger will carry the load in net coming off a 12 win season and playing the majority of the postseason games last year.

Both Miller and Mitchell were named to the ACHA Atlantic All Region team last year and will anchor the Vulcans defensive unit this season.

On the offensive side Warner, Locante and Bailey will anchor a unit that has plenty of new faces.

Familiar faces that'll join them on the offensive unit are Jake Blair, Tim Brown, Dustin Briggs, Ben Zalewski, Anthony Tonkovich and Bob Robison. Adding to the group will be freshman Tyler Gettel, Chris Siak and Alex Smith.

Helping to secure the defensive unit from last year's team are Zach Alaimo and Nick Blair along with new comers Nick Vacsulka, Jordan Lockhart, Tyler Kutek and Kyle Cunningham.

Backing up Zinger in net this season will be Garrett Hudson, who spent the past three

seasons as the Cal 2 team's top goaltender.

Not only are there many new faces among the Vulcans players, but also on the bench. Berger returns to head the bench for his 10th season along with long time Goaltending Coach Pat Kenny. Adding to the Vulcans coaching staff this season is Jason Greenway, who spent the past three seasons as an Assistant Coach for the Cal 2 team and BJ DePaoli making his coaching debut after a stellar playing career for the Vulcans.

As usual the Vulcans will play 12 CHE league games throughout the season. They will also travel back to The Classic in late November. Other schedule highlights include their third annual Homecoming Series and home contests against Farmingdale State and Bryn Athyn.

The Vulcans will also face other common non conference opponents in Richard Stockton, Loyola University, as well as new ones in Cleveland State, Xavier, Indiana University of PA, East Stroudsburg and East Carolina.

The Vulcans hopes is that their season will culminate in Pelham, Alabama for the 2015 ACHA Tournament.

California, PA- Doing it for Garrick the Vulcans (18-2, 9-0) controlled the play from start to finish on Friday evening against CHE rival Robert Morris University en route to a 6-2 victory.

It was the early relentless pressure that the Vulcans put on the Colonials that made the difference. In the span of 34 seconds the Vulcans took complete control with a two-goal lead. The first, on the power play, came from freshman Brad Mitchell with the second coming off the stick of Tom Graw.

The scoring died down until the second period when the Vulcans scored 20 seconds in on the power play from Mike Warner to take a 3-0 lead. Play through the second period remained very physical between the two teams. Right before the sides broke for intermission the Vulcans Mitch Fernandez added one more to make it 4-0 Vulcans.

Through two periods of play the Vulcans only surrendered six shots to the Colonials. Early in the third the Vulcans broke open the contest adding two more goals with a second from Graw and then Zalewski to make it 6-0 before the Colonials added two late goals of their own. In net Boyd Zinger stopped 17 of 19 shots faced while the Vulcans recorded 38 shots.

Garrick who passed away on November 23, 2013 as a result of an automobile accident was a senior at Cal U. Serving as the Vice-President of the Cal U Student Government Garrick was the hockey clubs cabinet representative for the 2013-14 season. He was a huge supporter of all three-hockey teams and also was a member of the Cal U Student Activities Board. This event saw the teams largest crowd ever at the Rostraver Ice Garden (486), and raised \$3,460 towards the Garrick Lackey Memorial Scholarship.

On Saturday April 4th, 2009 the California University of Pennsylvania Ice Hockey club honored General Manager Jamison Roth by retiring his number. Roth's retired number becomes the first in the clubs history.

In 2002 Jamison led the resurgence that brought the club back and on the path toward prominence where it currently sits today. Serving as the General Manager and Captain Jamison was able to oversee the building of the CHE team along with the addition of the CHA team and then the women's team.

Although, Roth's accomplishments were not limited to his off the ice work. He is one of the most decorated players in club history and ranks near the top in mostly every statistical category. After playing in 126 games Jamison finished with 171 goals and 125 assists for 296 points averaging 2.35 points per game. On the power play he recorded 55 goals for a total of 110 power play points. During his five years he managed to score 17 game winning goals. All of those currently have him ranked second overall. Jamison's 18 short-handed goals are the best in the club history.

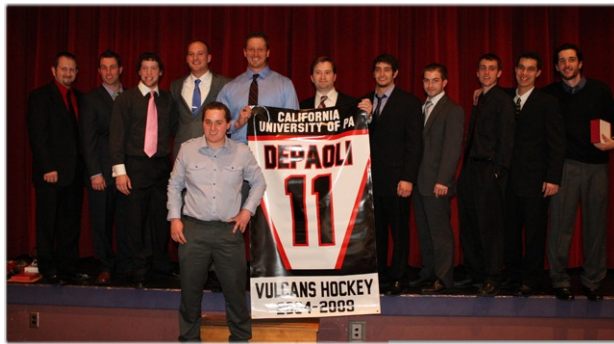
Jamison has also received numerous awards for his on and off the ice accomplishments. In 2003-04 he was named the CHE General Manager of the Year. After the 2006-07 season the ACHA honored Jamison by naming him to the ACHA Atlantic All-Region first team, and was also an ACHA Academic All-American. He was also honored by the CHE in 2006-07 when they awarded him the Student Athlete of a Lifetime renaming the award the Jamison Roth Student Athlete of the Year.

During his five years he also served as the teams captain for four seasons while serving as an alternate captain for one season.

Jamison still serves as the teams General Manager and is now the Director of Sports Clubs at California University of Pennsylvania.



For the second time in club history the Vulcans will raise a players name into rafters at the Bethel Park BladeRunners as BJ DePaoli's number 11 jersey was retired on Saturday April 14, 2012. At the clubs annual banquet General Manager Jamison Roth made the announcement that DePaoli would become the second player to have their number retired by the club. Prior to Saturday Roth's number 6 jersey was the only other retired number since he was given that honor in 2009.

The retiring of DePaoli's number does not come as a surprise as he is arguably one of the greatest players in club history. In his five-year career DePaoli set and broke numerous offensive records and was one of the

best players in the ACHA year in and out. Currently BJ holds the club career records for points, goals, assists, plus/minus and hat tricks.

While playing 122 games in those five years BJ recorded 179 goals and 234 assists for 413 points. He is the only player to record over 400 career points and his 413 points give him a 67 point advantage over Ryan Jones's 346. BJ also holds an astounding career plus/minus of 152 and has had 26 hat tricks. Per game for his career he averaged 1.46 goals, 1.91 assists and 3.38 points. BJ also ranks second all-time in power play goals and points along with being in the top five in short-handed and game winning goals.

DePaoli's numbers did not go unnoticed as he received numerous national and regional awards. Three times he was named an ACHA Division III Academic All-American. Twice he was named the ACHA Division III Atlantic Region Player of the Year, first team ACHA Division III All-American and first team ACHA Division III Atlantic All-Region. Once he was named second team ACHA Division III Atlantic All-Region, first team ACHA Division III All-Tournament Team and second team ACHA Division III All-Tournament Team. His most notable award came after the 2007/08 season when he was named the ACHA Division III National Player of the Year.

The awards were not limited to the ACHA as he was named the CHE Most Outstanding Forward three times and once the CHE Playoff MVP. BJ was also once voted by his teammates as the Cal U Most Valuable Player.

In the 2007/08 season BJ served as the teams captain when he was a member of the only ACHA Division III National Championship team in club history.

"BJ was a quiet person and didn't speak up too much, but he led by his actions on the ice" said Head Coach Justin Berger. "He was the type of player that could control a game when he put his mind to it as he did in the 2007/08 National Semi-Finals against Northern Colorado. He was instrumental in our early successes at Cal and helped it gain the recognition it gets today. He was one of the players that cut the path for classes after him to make wider."

California, PA- With family and friends amongst him, BJ DePaoli made both ACHA and Vulcan hockey history on May 3rd. DePaoli was formally inducted into the ACHA Hall of Fame becoming the first ever Vulcan player or staff member to receive that honor as well as the first ever Division III member to join the ACHA Hall of Fame.



"Having the first ever Division III player inducted into the hall of fame is a real statement on the program we have here," said Jamison Roth, Vulcans General Manager and former teammate of DePaoli's. "I couldn't think of a more deserving player in my 11 years with the ACHA that better demonstrates what it means to excel both on the ice and in the classroom. I think I speak for the program when I say we are very proud of BJ."

Being one of 14 ACHA Hall of Fame members and the only Division III member is just one of the many accolades that DePaoli has gained over the years. Most recently was in 2012 when he became the second Vulcans player to have his number retired by the club. While his two most recent awards may top the list, he accumulated many others during his playing days. BJ was a three time ACHA Division III Academic All-American. Twice he was named the ACHA Division III Atlantic Region Player of the Year, first team ACHA Division III All-American and first team ACHA Division III Atlantic All-Region. Once he was named second team ACHA Division III Atlantic All-Region, first team ACHA Division III All-Tournament Team and second team ACHA Division III All-Tournament Team. His most notable award came after the 2007/08 season when he was named the ACHA Division III National Player of the Year.

Although the awards were not limited to the ACHA as he was named the CHE Most Outstanding Forward three times and once the CHE Playoff MVP. BJ was also once voted by his teammates as the Cal U Most Valuable Player.

All of the accomplishments that DePaoli earned while on the ice and since his playing days ended have not gone unnoticed by the current Vulcans. Club President Brian Proud attended the induction ceremony and believes DePaoli's impact can still be felt throughout the organization.

"BJ has established the standard for Cal Hockey setting many club records while he maintained good grades during his tenure at Cal U. BJ was a part of the team when they brought a National Championship back to Cal U. His impact is felt here now, with the rich history of that National Championship, as well as from his demeanor on and off the ice", said Proud. "Although he was way before my time, I've heard nothing but great things from staff and alumni in regards to DePaoli. It was an honor to have had a player from our organization inducted into the Hall of Fame."

Since DePaoli left Cal U the Vulcans program has continued to rise among the ranks of top teams in the ACHA having won six CHE (College Hockey East) titles and four ACHA Atlantic Region titles. Also during that time the program has appeared in five ACHA National Tournaments and reached the Semi-Finals twice.

Not only has the success come on the ice but also the team has continued to gain significant university support as well as support from the surrounding community. "BJ's on ice performances and recognition's helped put Cal U hockey on the map back in 2004," Berger said. "Then leading us to a National Championship in 2008 has just enabled the program to build off of that momentum which ultimately allows us to draw some of the best players at the ACHA Division III level."

BJ graduated from Cal U with a 3.6 GPA and a degree in Political Science and is the
