The Clark County School District (CCSD) Research Department is collecting data for the Educational Operations Unit, Athletics and Activities Department, regarding interest in CCSD Athletics. We are asking that your students complete the *Student Athletic Interest Survey*, which is designed to increase participation within all school's athletic programs. Student preferences, perceptions, and attitudes are a critical component in creating successful athletic programs leading to positive outcomes that benefit students.

**Please note that the Student Athletic Interest Survey is to be completed by students in grades 8-11 only. It will launch on Monday, September 14 and be available through Thursday, October 29, 2015.** The survey is brief and will only take a few minutes to complete. Students will be able to take the survey at their individual school site through any CCSD networked computer. An icon will be placed on networked school computer desktops with a link to the survey. Students will be required to enter their school identification number to insure validity of the respondent and prevent duplication of responses.

**We ask that school principals forward the survey link to all site administrators and teachers in their building. Please have staff arrange for students to complete the survey no later than Thursday, October 29 at 5:00 p.m.** *All responses are confidential and anonymity will be maintained without qualification.*

**Instructions:** A **Student Interest Survey** shortcut will be installed by User Support Services through your school's network. The shortcut will be added to both the Windows Start Menu and the computer desktop. Depending on your school's network, the shortcut might not be displayed on the desktop for student users. In these cases, the icon will still be displayed in the Windows Start Menu.
