ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MANKATO WEST BOOSTER CLUB

The undersigned Incorporator, being a natural person of full age, in order to form a non-profit corporation under Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 317A, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this Corporation is MANKATO WEST BOOSTER CLUB.

ARTICLE II.

The registered office of this Corporation is located at 1558 Nottingham Drive, North Mankato, Minnesota 56003. The registered agent at that address is Marilyn Rosenau.

ARTICLE III.

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as now enforced or hereafter amended, and including, for such purposes, to promote and foster athletic competition and other athletic activities at West High School, Independent School District 77, Mankato, Minnesota.

ARTICLE IV.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on:

- a. By a Corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law); or

- b. By a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

The Corporation shall not, directly or indirectly, influence or attempt to influence the policies of the institutions and units receiving financial assistance from it.

ARTICLE V.

The Corporation shall not afford pecuniary gain, incidentally or otherwise, to its members.

ARTICLE VI.

The duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE VII.

The affairs of this Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The manner of election of the Directors, together with their terms of office and number, shall be prescribed by the By-laws.

ARTICLE VIII.

An action required or permitted to be taken by the Board of Directors of this Corporation may be taken by written action signed by that number of Directors that would be required to take the same action at a meeting of the Board at which all Directors are present, except as to those matters requiring membership approval.

Upon dissolution, termination or winding up of this Corporation in any manner or for any reason whatsoever, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious literary or scientific purposes, as shall at the time qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.




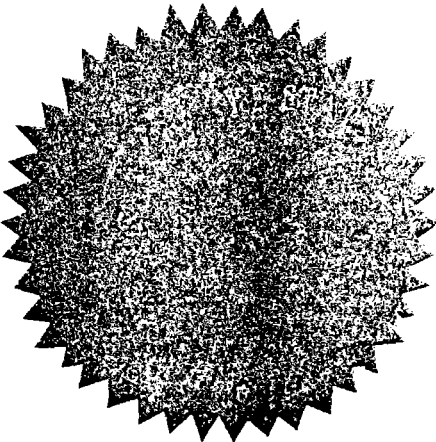
