Tournament Format: A 16-man championship bracket. There is no cross bracketing used in our tournament format. Therefore, we will follow the double elimination structure (2 losses for elimination). Wrestlers that lose in the preliminary rounds will go into the consolation bracket (5<sup>th</sup> place). Winners in the preliminary rounds will go into the championship bracket – (1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place). Weight classes will be assigned to a mat with the exception of two weight classes which will be called the “floater weights”. This means that each mat will be assigned 3 weight classes. The matches in the floater weights will be wrestled at the end of a round on a first available mat

basis. Wrestling will be conducted on 4 mats, with three weight classes on a mat. The Championship and Consolation matches will take place in the afternoon session on 3 mats. The Championship, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place, and 5<sup>th</sup> Place matches will be wrestled simultaneously for each weight on an assigned mat, beginning with the 106 pound weight class. (See the mat assignment sheet for more information.) **The tournament will be scored using Track wrestling. All teams and coaches have been assigned a “password” to enter their team’s information (please check your schools “spam” in case you didn’t receive yours through your regular email). Passwords will be emailed out by David Irish by January 1<sup>st</sup>. Deadlines for entries are posted on Track Wrestling. Time Schedule: Doors open at 7:15 AM. (30 minutes prior to weigh in’s)  
Weigh-in 7:45 in the old gym – north (3 scales).  
Coaches’ Meeting 8:30 AM in the old gym – south.  
Prelims begin at 10:00 AM on **4 mats. Approximate Start Time:**  
(we will start earlier if seeding and coaches meeting ends earlier)  
Consolation and Championship 5:30 PM on **3 mats.**

Weigh-in Times: Weigh-ins will be conducted by weight class in the old gym according to WIAA procedures, using three scales. A 3-pound weight allowance total will be given for the tournament (some teams are wrestling Friday night) i.e. 106 can weigh 109 pounds at weigh in on Saturday morning.

Seeding: Seeding will be done by Track Wrestling. Seeding criteria for this meet can be found on the Track Wrestling website. **Coaches must pay close attention when entering the seeding information for their wrestlers. Any information not added by the deadline will NOT be considered at the seeding meeting. At the seeding meeting, only challenges to the TOP 4 seeds will be considered.**

Entry Information: All entries will be handled by Track Wrestling. Schools will be contacted by Track Wrestling and given a username and password, along with step-by-step instructions to allow them to enter their line-ups online. There will be 2 windows of time for you to enter information about your wrestlers.

1. Please adhere to the deadlines posted on **Track Wrestling** regarding your entries. **Line-ups cannot be changed after the final deadline. This deadline is designed to prevent coaches from moving their wrestlers to other weight classes once they are able to see which opponents are entered in each weight class.**
2. Once the deadline expires, **You will be locked out of the entry process. Any information not added by the deadline will NOT be considered at the seeding meeting.**

**At the seeding meeting, only challenges to the TOP 4 Seeds will be considered.**

Entry Fee: \$25 per wrestler or \$215 per team, whichever is less for your school.

Awards: Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> place in each weight class.  
Outstanding Wrestler Award (to be determined by a vote of head coaches and officials)  
There will be two Divisions for the purpose of determining Team Awards. The largest six schools will be placed into Division 1, and the remaining 11 schools will be placed into Division 2. Team Trophies will be given to 1<sup>st</sup> Place teams in each division.
