

BYAA Volleyball Rules

1. Games

- All games will be **THREE** sets regardless of scores, rotating sides each set
- The first two sets will start at 0-0 played to 25, win by two, **NO CAP**
- The third set will start at 0-0 played to 15, switching sides at 8, win by two, **NO CAP**
- Three minutes will be allowed in-between sets

2. Serving

- Underhand Serving is allowed
 - Player must release ball before contact
- Server will get one re-serve on first serving attempt
- Server is limited to 5 serving points, after 5 points an automatic sideout will happen
- Servers are allowed 2 tosses per serving attempt, serving fault will be called
- For 3rd/4th grade the server must serve behind the 10ft line
- For 5th/6th grade players may step in 6'6" from the end line
- The server may not foot fault, they will receive **ONE** warning per game, the next time will result as a serving error

3. Ball Handling

- Only three touches are allowed per side
- Double hits will be called
- Lifts will be called on a light basis

4. Rotation

- All players must rotate in and play equally
- Starting lineups must be different each set
- Serving position is in right back
- Players will rotate on every side out
- Six players on the court at a time
 - Teams may play with less than six players
- Borrowing Players:
 - Teams may borrow players from younger age division

- Teams can borrow players from same league with opposing coach approval

5. Pre-Game Duties

- Ref will call captains for coin toss
 - Captains need to alternate each game
- Ref will assign each team a side of the coin
- Winning team may call serve or receive

6. Violations

- Net violations will only be called if it interferes with the play
- Centerline may be crossed if player doesn't interfere with play
- No Pursuit Rule

7. Court

- We will be using a regular size volleyball court 18x9 meters
- The net will be regulation height 7'0 for both leagues
- Players may play up to basketball half court line, they must have one foot on their side of the court. If they cross the line the ref will whistle and blow play dead.

Volley-Lite volleyballs will be the official ball used for both leagues

Teams will be allowed two 30-second timeouts per set

A maximum of 3 coaches may be on the bench (2 adults and 1 High School Player)

A binder will be kept to record all scores throughout the season

- Both Head Coaches and Ref must sign binder after every game to verify scores

Jerseys must be worn at all times

Two parents from each team will be required to line judge each game and assist the official when asked upon.

Coaches please make sure and clean up trash after every game

NO BALL HANDLING DURING OTHER TEAMS GAMES!

Poor sportsmanship WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

OFFICIAL'S DECISION IS FINAL, NO PROTESTING CALLS!!!
