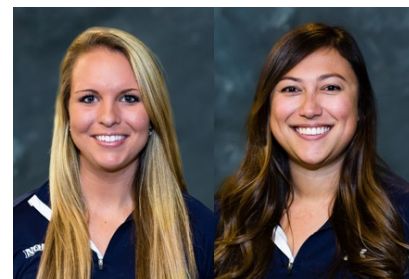

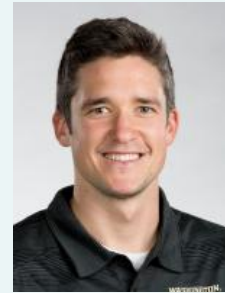
## Mary Wise Returns on March 1st!

Congratulations to all of our teams that played in the NORCO Collegiate Showcase. More than 20 local area colleges were invited to attend and appearances were made by Colorado State, University of Denver, Northern Colorado,

Wyoming, Regis, Colorado School of Mines, Colorado College, Johnson & Wales, Laramie Community College and Northeastern Junior College.

Immediately following the Showcase, Director of Volleyball Operations Gavin Markovits hosted a recruiting seminar for parents and players. He educated everyone through the often confusing recruiting process!



Each year the NORCO coaches conduct player evals and provide the players with a written copy of the club form. At 15 and under, coaches are to conduct 2 player evals before the end of the season; 16 and up, 1 time during the season. We find this assessment tool to be very beneficial to players and coaches. Please ask your coaches about this process. Evaluations are not to take place during court time and both coaches need to be present. Average scheduling of these is approximately 10 minutes per player.

Now that all teams are beginning tournament play, make sure to check your practice calendar often! Teams may be practicing on days they might not normally due to traveling teams and long tournaments.
