**Session I**

**Session I Schedule: Age 8 and Below**

09:30 AM - Ticket sales begin & gates open  
10:00 AM - Wrestlers, Parents & Coaches report to team's area in stands (See your team set-up person.)  
10:00 AM - Head Table Workers from each team report to head table (Session I bracket & bout sheets filled out.)  
10:30 AM - Coaches & Directors turn in scratch cards to the Backroom or Main Head Table per PA announcement  
10:30 AM - 8 & Under wrestlers & coaches meet at team's area in stands  
10:30 AM - Referees' meeting  
10:30 AM - Head Table meeting one per table (Tables 1-12 on mat 1)  
10:30 AM - Head Table meeting one per table (Tables 13-24 on mat 24)  
10:30 AM - Clerks of Course from each team report to their head table, pick up 1<sup>st</sup> round Session I bout sheets  
➤ Scratches after this will be done by the mat # Head Table  
10:40 AM - Mat-Side Table Workers report to team's mat #  
10:45 AM - First group #'s called to Staging  
10:50 AM - Clear mats (National Anthem)  
11:00 AM - Wrestling begins for ages 8 & Under

**Session II**

*There is no intermission between sessions I & II when the first session ends on a mat section (1 to 24) the second session wrestlers need to be ready to start as soon as Session I ends –  
It is the responsibility of the mat side table workers to have wrestlers ready*

**Session II Schedule: Age 9 - 13**

2:45 PM - Age 9 & Over wrestlers start to report to team's area in the stands  
3:30 PM - All session II bracket & bout sheets picked up by head tables  
3:30 PM - Coaches & Directors Final Call for Session II scratches  
3:30 PM - Head Table & Mat side workers for session II must report to team's area in stands (If different from session I)  
3:30 PM - Session II Clerks of Course from each team report to the Backroom and pick up 1<sup>st</sup> round Session II bout sheets  
3:30 PM - Session II table workers report (per AM session conclusion)  
3:45 PM - Earliest calls for 9 & Over group #'s to staging  
➤ **Times Below are Approximate:**  
3:45 PM - Wrestling begins for ages 9 & Over (all mats –some mats will start earlier)  
7:15 PM - Wrestling starts to end for ages 9 & Over  
7:15 PM - Clean-up workers, per team assignments, report to designated area - see Ron Browning or the head table for assignments if you don't know

General Information

**NO CARRY-INS: NO FOOD, NO COOLERS, NO CANS and NO BOTTLES CAN BE BROUGHT IN**

**Wrestler's age 9 & Over do not need to arrive at the Nutter Center until 2:30 pm.**

Admission: \$10 [cash only] (Free: 13 & Under, coaches showing a USA Coaches Card and referees with a contract/uniform)  
➤ Note: MVKWA Coach's Floor Pass does NOT get a coach in for free. Only free with USA Coach's Card.

Parking: \$5 per car (can come & go with no parking charge when coming back in to lot after leaving)

**NO CARRY-INS: NO FOOD, NO COOLERS, NO CANS and NO BOTTLES CAN BE BROUGHT IN.**

**Tournament setup:**

- 1 8 man brackets, double elimination
- 2 Anyone who's weight is checked and found to be past the 4% max allowance will be DQ (No argument)
- 3 Pairing by age, weight, and then win/loss records
- 4 Observance of Ohio High School rules
- 5 Three 1 minute periods
- 6 Sudden Death Overtime: 1 min. 1st period; if 2nd period, 30 sec
- 7 Reasonable uniform and shoes permitted
- 8 Headgear is not required
- 9 Hair coverings are required, including headgear, for long hair (see OHSAA/NFHS rule 4, section 2, article 1)
- 10 Wrestlers must have a USA wrestling card
- 11 Must have 1 parent in the staging and at the mat for wrestlers ages 6 & under
- 12 No parents in staging or at the mat for wrestlers ages 7 & over
- 13 Must have 1 coach or parent mat side for wrestler age 6 & below
- 14 All MVKWA teams have work assignments, and all workers must be on time.

**Bullpen:**

Each team's area in the stands is termed a "bullpen". Each team should have 2-3 parents as "bullpen parents". These parents will need a list of all the team's wrestler's in-group # order. These parents can ensure each wrestler has his group # and mat # marked on this hand. These parents can use this list to make sure that each time the announcer calls a group # to report to staging, that the wrestler and his parent gets there. Let's keep the number of forfeits to zero!

**Points of Emphasis:**

1. Announcer calls wrestlers to staging by mat & group #
2. No individual wrestler's name will be announced
3. Wrestlers must report to staging for byes
4. If a wrestler misses his group's call to the staging area & clerk of course can't locate, **it will be a forfeit**
5. **All of a wrestler's matches are on same mat # section. Matches will move near the end of the sessions.**
6. On-Deck wrestlers must be at mat side table w/ leg bands on
7. Parent & wrestler are to clear floor right after match
8. Referees' decisions are final. OHSAA rules strictly followed
9. Wrestler is done when places 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> or loses two matches
10. Age & weight bracket sheets will be posted - Please leave on the walls until session is complete.
11. Head Table Worker verifies wrestler turning in bout sheet has name circled on bout sheet
12. All wrestlers receive ribbons
