



Arapahoe Ice Warriors Booster Club Meeting

September 15, 2015

President Jeff Berven called the Arapahoe Ice Warriors Booster Club Meeting to order at 6:32 pm on September 15, 2015.

Introductions: Booster Club officers introduced themselves. One representative from each travel team is required to attend meetings during the season. The attending representative does not have to be the team manager. Teams could use SignUp Genius to ask different parents to take a turn attending. Meetings are held on the second Tuesday of the month (unless otherwise noted on the AYHL website) in Skybox 1.

Booster Club Vice President and Treasurer positions are open (for vote at the January meeting). Job descriptions are available online in the Booster Club bylaws.

Treasurer's Report:

Lori Lomen reported (as interim Treasurer) as follows: starting balance at \$18,716.29. Donations of \$2,322.50 (from the Bantams) and \$1,500 (from Peeweesees) were received for the scholarship fund from the summer skills sessions.

Current balance is \$17,942.92 after paying expenses (P.O. Box renewal, helmet decals, practice jerseys, and coaching software).

Booster Club dues are \$40/per player on each travel team. Team managers should collect dues and turn in to the Booster Club no later than the date of the next meeting (October 13, 2015).

Old Business:

- **Snapbooster Texting Fundraising:** Easy team fundraising – snap pictures of receipts and text to Snapbooster. Reports are coded by team and funds are disbursed each month by team. Nicole Capra to send out a flier detailing information. Snapbooster

does not sell any user information, and monthly emails detail retailers that are currently offering bonus snap funds.

➤ **AYHL Website**

Each team has a page (to display practice and game schedules). Each team manager should have access to update their page. Encourage all team parents to have their own login for team updates. Families who will assist with scoring games will need to have a login. Ice Office (Christine and Susan) will be available for training on SportNginer as season begins.

New Business:

➤ **2015-2016 Season Scholarships:**

- Scholarship application is available on the website, due in by October 15, 2015. Scholarships will be awarded on October 23, 2015.
- Managers should communicate with team families regarding the availability of scholarship funds.

➤ **59-Minute Fundraising Program:**

- Using on a trial basis – Nicole Capra is point person for teams interested in scheduling.
- Booster Club will cover player incentives.
- Players come with 25+ names/numbers to call and ask for support for the season (scripted message).

➤ **CCYHL:** Getting game schedule out to start tiering.
