September Minutes: Approved.

Treasurer's Report – Jeff Berven:

Tax return successfully filed (via e-card – approved under \$50,000 threshold) for Booster Club by interim treasurer Lori Lomen.

Goalie Coach (Dean Clemens) has been hired and will be paid by Booster Club. Each travel team should expect to see him approximately three times per month (depending upon practice schedules). He will work with goalies in the first 10-15 minutes of practice.

Balance is \$14,300 (prior to scholarship disbursement).

Booster Club dues are \$40/per player on each travel team (covers practice jerseys, decals, numbers, coaching software for head coaches, goalie/skills coaching during practices). Team managers should collect dues and turn in as soon as possible.

Old Business:

- **Scholarship Last Call:** Scholarship deadline is Friday, October 15 – funds paid directly to Ice Office to offset final travel installment.
- **Fundraising - :** Easy team fundraising – snap pictures of receipts and text to Snapbooster. Reports are coded by team and funds are disbursed each month by team. Nicole Capra to send out a flier detailing information. Snapbooster does not sell any user information, and monthly emails detail retailers that are currently offering bonus snap funds.
