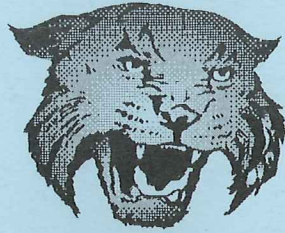

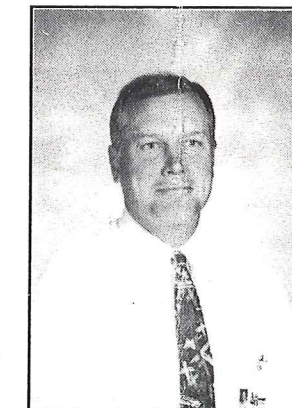

## BENGAL PRIDE ON ICE 1996-97 RECAP

Led by senior co-captains **Laura Tryba** and **Bethany Howard**, the Bengals recovered from a disappointing 0 - 3 - 1 start to capture 3 trophies in the 1996-97 season.

We won the **Twin Cities Suburban West Conference Championship** with an 11 - 2 record, losing only to White Bear Lake in overtime and Roseville.

After shutout victories against Coon Rapids and Orono/Mound-Westonka in the Section 7 playoffs, Blaine met Park Center for the title, in what turned out to be a thrilling double overtime 3 - 2 victory for our Bengals. When **Laura Tryba** scored the game-winner on our 55th shot on goal, the **Section 7 Champions** were headed back to the State Tournament for their second consecutive appearance.

The Bengals met the Section 1 winners, Owatonna, in the quarterfinal round. The Pioneer Press headline the next day said it all, "*Tryba scores 5 goals; Blaine rips Owatonna*". Goals by **Jenny Penner**, **Amanda Brandt**, **Micki Hubert** and **Katie Dierkhising**, along with a 21 save shutout performance by **Katie Beauduy**, resulted in a 9 - 0 victory and a rematch with the Hibbing Bluejackets. Unfortunately for our Bengals, the Jackets' **Amber Fryklund** scored 3 goals to lead her team to a 4 - 2 win. The loss forced Blaine into the third place game against conference rival Mounds View. Goals by **Tryba**, **Kim Oseth** and **Lindsey Kuehn** resulted in a 3 - 1 victory as the **Third Place State Tournament Trophy** found its way into the Blaine High School trophy case for the second consecutive year.

## CONTINUING THE BENGAL PRIDE 1997-98

Buoyed by the fact that the excellent coaching staff of Head Coach **Marci Bydlon**, Goalie Coach **Steve Guider** and Assistant Coach **Gina Houser** is returning intact, the Bengals are anxious to return to the ice to defend their titles. Tri-captains **Dierkhising**, **Brandt** and **Penner** will lead the Bengals in their quest to return to the state tournament. All-Conference returnees **Dierkhising**, **Brandt**, **Kuehn** and **Beauduy** give the Bengals a solid base from which to build a contending team.

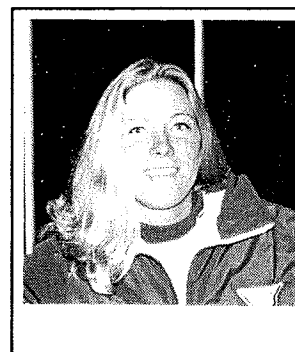
This team has had great success because of the commitment, dedication, and the desire these athletes bring to the program. *They have paved the way for many!*

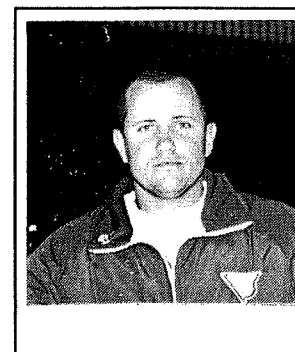
**Marci Bydlon**, Head Varsity Coach

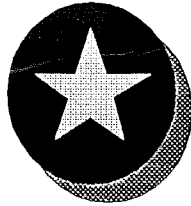
**Gina Houser**, Junior Varsity Coach

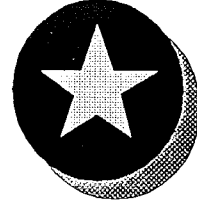


**Steve Guider**, Goalie Coach

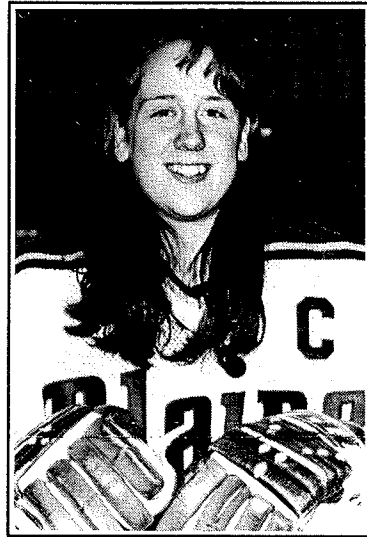

## TRI-CAPTAINS



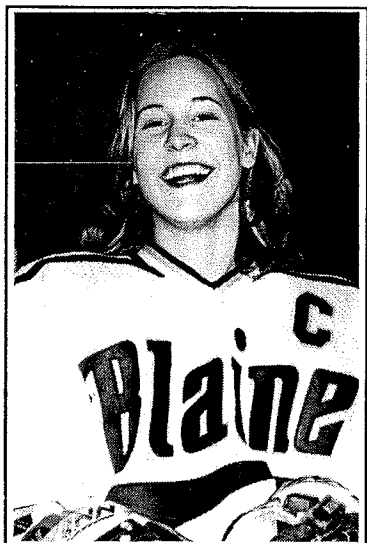

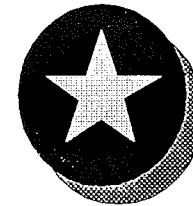

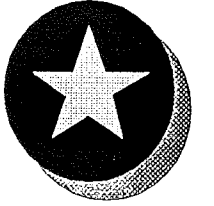

I grew up with 3 brothers that played hockey. By the time I understood the game, I was so sick of it, I hated the sport. I was a girl, girls don't play hockey. That was my excuse for not playing when my dad would ask me. I was a ballerina at heart. I started tumbling when I was 3 or so. I switched from tumbling to dance and gymnastics. After 10 years, I didn't want to dance anymore. It just wasn't fun. So I quit dance right before 9th grade. I played fall soccer for the H.S. I was planning on doing gymnastics during the winter, but Kelly Pajak told me about girls hockey. I didn't know we had a team. She asked me if I could skate. That was an easy answer, I couldn't skate so I couldn't play. Then Jodi Stephaniak told me about her skating. They told me about captains practice and told me I should just try.

I asked my parents if they could help me find hockey equipment. My moms jaw dropped! I never mentioned anything before. My parents asked me alot of questions I had no answers, beside when and where practice was. My dad helped me get my stuff. My stick was too long, my skates were too big, and everything **stunk!** I went to practice. I couldn't stop, much less actually skate, but there was something in me that told me to keep trying. Tryouts came, I wasn't even nervous. I just felt stupid, but not too stupid because there were 2 dozen other girls who couldn't skate. Saturday morning after tryouts, I wasn't sure if I should expect a call for Varsity or J.V. I didn't think there was any way she could put someone as bad as me on the team. I had scrimmaged with the varsity so I new there was a chance, when I got that call, I was dumb-founded. I couldn't believe my ears the coach must have called the wrong number. No way could she have just said I made varsity. I told my mom and she cried, well, first she laughed at me and told me to tell her the truth then she hugged me and cried. I assumed there were other freshman, but I was the only one at equipment pick-up.

After that my life changed. The ability to do things became easier. I improved faster than most girls, who had started the same time I did. I was proud of myself. After 9th grade, I still couldn't really control my skating much less the puck. Sophomore year brought more rapid changes. I moved up a line, and I could skate (for the most part), under control. I worked hard to improve all aspects of my game. My 10th grade year brought about the most change. By my junior year I had an actual slap shot. Not so hard, or accurate, but I had a better shot. I worked on my shooting, with the help of Tryba and Gina. I really had to work hard playing with Tryba. Everything came together my junior year. The knowledge of the game I learned as I grew up, and the ability to skate and use that knowledge really fell in place. Going to state that year was the greatest accomplishment for me. This summer, I worked harder than I have ever worked. I've applied myself, I've become stronger physically, and with my skating. I have improved not only for me but for the team.

Being a captain means more than a title, it has to be proven everyday. In the effort put in practice, to understanding a drill Marcy describes, and demonstrate it. I don't want to be a captain that watches victories and losses. I want to be the player involved in the wins and losses. 
WHEREAS, the members of the team exemplify the qualities of hard work, training, teamwork, and sportsmanship; and

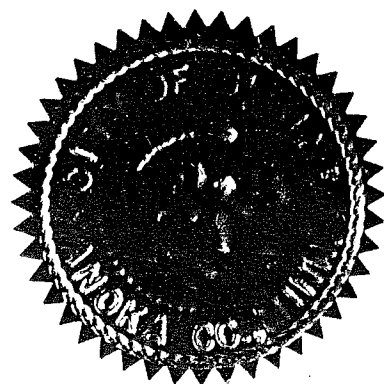
WHEREAS, the Coach, Assistant Coaches, and trainers have devoted themselves to guiding and assisting the team; and
