*1997-98 Recap/Outlook*

The 1997-98 season was filled with numerous close calls. The Bengals quite frankly had difficulty scoring goals in crucial situations, which led to a 10-10-4 overall record. Although we allowed just 39 goals in 24 games the offense produced only 53, not quite enough to be ranked among the state's elite teams.

Five Bengal opponents made it to the state tournament proving that we play one of the toughest schedules in the state. Against those teams we had a record of 2 wins 4 losses and 1 tie although three of the losses were by one goal. Blaine defeated the Hibbing Bluejackets, who took home the runner-up trophy, 2-1 in OT and tied the 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners, the Roseville Raiders, 1-1 in OT in two of our most exciting and satisfying games of the regular season.

The Park Center Pirates denied the Bengals a third straight trip to the State Tournament in the Section 7 semi-finals (2-1 in OT).

The Bengals played in nine overtime games and five others were decided by one goal ... that's tough on the parents, especially the goalie's mom. More favorable outcomes are wished for this year.

The 1998-99 edition of the Bengals has a great cast of players determined to get back to the state tournament after a one-year hiatus. The early season schedule will provide a glimpse at what the Bengals must do to achieve their goals. In our first five games the Bengals tangle with 5 teams who finished in last year's final Let's Play Hockey Top Twenty including #2 Hibbing and #3 Roseville. Later on we play Anoka, Mounds View, Stillwater and Park Center who could all be top ten teams this year. The Bengals may play the strongest schedule in the state this year. One of the keys to a successful season will be finding a way to score those critical goals in the third period of the close games.

Eight seniors, Shannon Adams, Alissa Aune, Tracy Hartman, Michelle Hubert, Kate Lindsey, Kyla Murphy, Lindsey Kuehn and Katie Beauduy, will provide the leadership to surpass all expectations except their own. Juniors Jessie Stewart-Calvert and Rachel Nelson, sophomores Jennie Bunker, Christa Hubert, Erin O'Neil and Laura Cecko and freshmen Tiffany Hagge and Andrea Jensrud round out the senior high school players on the team. Kristina Bunker, the first 7<sup>th</sup> grader to play varsity hockey at Blaine, is a welcome addition to the squad.





### A MESSAGE FROM COACH BYDLON

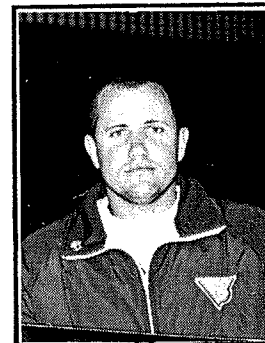

This team has had great success because of the commitment, dedication and desire these student-athletes bring to the program. *They have paved the way for future high school, college and Olympic stars!*

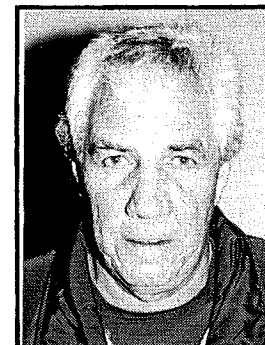

Entering her senior season Katie Beauduy has tended goal in 77 consecutive games for Marci Bydlon's Blaine Bengals. She has started every game since her freshman year. For some it might seem that it has all been easy for the diminutive goalie. GN: What are some memories of your first year?

GN: What is the difference when you are struggling versus playing well?

KT: The puck is like a ping pong ball. I have trouble following it, seeing it, it seems out of focus. When I'm playing well every shot is clear. It just feels right. Everything breaks away and all I see is the puck. Even if it comes through a screen I can always see the puck. When the other team scores I'm mad at myself because I think I could've stopped it no matter what kind of goal it was ... When my team wins that's more important to me than if I play good.

GN: What are your best memories?

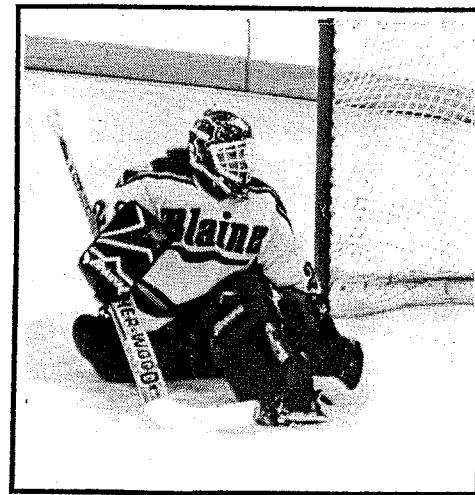
KT: (As a sophomore) I remember riding down the hallway with Tryba on a luggage cart at the hotel during the state tournament. We were BLAINE without the Coon Rapids tag. It was nice. We beat Park Center 2-1 in double OT in the section finals. (As a junior) We beat Hibbing 2-1 in OT and tied Roseville 1-1. They finished second and third in State ... and bus trips. The out of town trips were really fun. Just being with my teammates, having fun. Going to State two years and sharing that with my teammates.

GN: What is your role as a captain and what are your expectations for this year?

KT: I'm not a rah-rah person so I need to lead by example ... If we really try, work hard, come together, we can make it to State. I'm really optimistic.
