1. Minutes

The minutes of the March meeting were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

The fee for the track meet was \$150 per school or \$9.00 per student. If you have not already done so, please mail the track fee as well as any outstanding basketball or PLACT training fees to Mike Milligan.

All outstanding fees must be paid in full to enroll any teams in volleyball or soccer next year.

Mike gave out a thorough report on the money made this year at the basketball tournaments. In the summer Mike will explore using a different bank, one that might provide free checking or online banking.

The treasurer’s report was approved. Thank you, Mike, for your excellent work as treasurer of the CGSAA.

3. Unfinished Business

There was no unfinished business.

4. Soccer

Division Four (7th and 8th grade) teams will stay eleven on eleven next year. Sixth grade will not be able to play up in Division Four. There are no rule changes for next year.

The number of soccer teams from each school will be due at the August meeting. Games will begin September 10th. Keiffer will need the player and coach rosters by September 8. Every school will need to send two volunteers to stock the concession stand on a Friday evening before Saturday games. Keiffer will set up a spread sheet with sign-up dates. St. Eugene's will take the first weekend.

5. Volleyball

The number of volleyball teams and gym availability will be due at the August meeting. Games will begin September 10th. Diane will need the player and coach rosters by September 8.

The Big Twelve games will start on August 23. Diane will send out a notification and schedule of the games this summer so that each school can sign up for these extra games.
