All-Star Selection Process

The President of Robinson Little League shall appoint an All-Star Committee to fairly & impartially oversee the selection of the most skilled & competitive players for All-Star play. The All-Star Committee will also approve the managers, coaches and players as they will represent Robinson Little League.

The managers, coaches & players selected will represent Robinson Little League and are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner. If, at any time, a manager, coach or player acts in a manner unbecoming of Robinson Little League, that person can be removed from their position by the RLL Board. All players are expected to participate in all practices and games until the All-Star season is over.

The selection process will start by determining where each team placed in division rankings. In the event of a tie, the total "runs against" will be subtracted from the total "runs for" for each tied team. The difference will be the tie breaker, the higher number beats lower number.

Manager Selection:

The first place team's manager in each division shall manage that division's All-Star team. The All-Star team manager shall select two coaches to assist in coaching the All-Star team. All managers and coaches must be approved by the All-Star Committee.

Player Selection:

Each manager shall nominate eligible players from any team and place them on a ballot. The number of nominations allowed for each manager is determined by his/her team's ranking in regular season play. See Nominations/Votes Guidelines on the following page for details. The All-Star Committee suggests the managers discuss their selections prior to nominating so as to select the best team possible. Each manager shall state the reason each player deserves to make all-star, list positions played, place in batting order and note any limitations. Discussion should take place and questions can be asked by other managers about the order of the players.

Eligible Players: Players must meet the age requirements for the all-star division they are being selected for. The 2017 Little League Age Chart will verify league age. Players must also be able to produce the required paperwork.

A nomination sheet will be given to the 2nd place team's manager for them to write their nominees on. Next, the nomination sheet will be given to the 3rd place team's manager for them to write their nominees on. Players cannot be nominated more than once. This should continue with each manager until the last place team's manager has written their nominations on the nomination sheet. The All-Star Committee can approve or deny any of the nominations. If the All-Star Committee approves nominations the list of nominees shall be placed on a ballot. Each manager shall cast votes for nominated players on the ballot they think is best suited for the All-Star team. A manager cannot place more than one vote per player. In the event of a tie, the All-Star manger decides which player wins. The number of votes each manager gets is listed under Nomination/Votes Guidelines.

After the All-Star Committee counts all the votes cast, the winning players will be announced to the managers. The All-Star manager shall then select the remainder of the team from all eligible players. The decision to have 12 or 13 players will be left up to each All-Star team's manager. If the manager decides to have 13 players, that extra player shall be selected by the All-Star team's manager.

2nd Place - 5 Nominations

3rd Place – 4 Nominations

4th Place – 3 Nominations

1st Place – 6 Picks from any team in division

Each manager has 6 votes

5 Team Division

2nd Place – 5 Nominations

3rd Place – 4 Nominations

4th Place – 3 Nominations

5th Place – 2 Nominations

1st Place – 6 Picks from any team in division

Each manager has 6 votes

6 Team Division

2nd Place – 5 Nominations

3rd Place – 4 Nominations

4th Place – 3 Nominations

5th Place – 2 Nominations

6th Place – 1 Nomination

1st Place – 6 Picks from any team in division

Each manager has 6 votes

All-Star players can be announced on June 1st, and teams can start practice the same day.
