The Nighthawks, Kenny Jones-Coach are filing an appeal to a Protest upheld against the Nighthawks. The Protest was filed by The Chargers, Brett Chaffin & Dennis Stevens-Coaches. The protest was initially heard by the JRC. The JRC determined the game would result in a forfeit by the Nighthawks and the Chargers would be awarded the win for game

At 8:57 p.m. the board deliberates, with all members in favor (7-0), Protest filed by the Chargers against the Nighthawks did not require further action by the Board since the game in question was in violation of NAGAAA IOG Ch 20.22(D) (A player rated a 13 playing in the D division is an ineligible player). Further violation occurred under HSL Section 6-A-6, a player must satisfy any and all other requirements for participation as may be established by NAGAAA and/or HSL. Consequently, violation of the above rules results in a forfeit of the game regardless of the protest filed as outlined in Sections 6 and 10 of the HSL Rules and Regulations.

Item 2

A Special Circumstance Grievance was filed by the Chargers against Armando Villena of the Nighthawks. A discussion with Dennis and Brett occurred discussing the statements made by Armando Villena. Dennis and Brett were asked to leave the room for deliberation by the Executive Board. In lieu of Executive Board vote on the grievance filed, the Chargers coaches subsequently agreed to allow the executive board to determine the penalty as opposed to requiring a meeting of the entire Summer Softball Council.

Executive Board voted 7-0 to place Armando Villena on a five (5) game probation for unsportsmanlike conduct under Rules and Regulations 13(A)(2)

Item 3

Kyle Erickson of the WILD filed an Appeal of their 2017 GSWS fine. The Executive Board Deliberates and a vote is held. Jeff Langer moves to uphold the fine, Terry McGee seconds. Vote 4-1-1
