Safety Regulations

The regulations listed below are intended to make the swimming area at the Keith Koster Park safe and enjoyable for you and your family. The swimming area is supervised by certified lifeguards who are empowered to revoke or suspend a Member's privileges for violations of any of these regulations.

- No fishing tackle allowed near beach, docks, or recreational area
- Members are not allowed to lend their wristbands to anyone outside of their immediate family.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- For safety purposes, an "Adult swim" will be conducted on a daily basis. All members and guests under 18 years of age must exit the water during this time period.
- Dogs, horses, and other animals not allowed.
- Motorboats are not to be launched from the beach.
- No running or roughhousing on the docks at any time.

Safety Regulations
