

MYHA Scrip Program

The Monroe Youth Hockey Association is pleased to offer the Shop With Scrip fundraising program. Shop With Scrip allows MYHA families to earn rebates which can be credited towards association fees as well as raise funds for MYHA. There are several families in the association that have been playing hockey for free or at GREATLY reduced fees since MYHA began using Scrip!

Scrip gift cards are the same gift cards you would normally buy at a store. Many popular retailers participate in the scrip program including Kohl's, Amazon, Wal-Mart, iTunes, Pick 'n Save, Kwik Trip, and many others. You can see them all at www.shopwithscrip.com.

Many cards are electronically reloadable. This features can be used anytime, not just when the monthly association order is submitted. There is a smartphone app that you can use to purchase and redeem ScripNow while in a store or restaurant, gift cards are available almost immediately.

If you're not familiar with how a scrip program works, it's simple. MYHA families buy the gift cards for Scrip participating retailers at full face value and redeem them for full face value. Each gift card you buy will have a percentage assigned to it, which you will know before purchasing. Most are in the 1.5-5 percent range, but many are higher.

Of that percentage, your family will retain 90% of it as a scrip rebate credit within the association for your family's hockey fees/fundraising requirements. MYHA will retain the other 10% for program administration and fundraising.

For example, JC Penney's cards offer a 5% rebate on their cards. If you buy a \$100 gift card, at a cost to you of \$100, you can use the card at any JC Penney's and spend the full \$100. The great part is, you just took \$4.50 off of your registration fees and earned MYHA \$.50.

If you're still wondering what the catch is... The catch, if you consider it one, is that families need to spend money on gift cards ahead of time. Instead of paying cash or putting purchases on a credit card and paying for it later, pay for it in advance with scrip, and then do your normal shopping for groceries, gas, clothing, electronics, You can place your orders any time online, but MYHA only submits an order once a month. The second to last Friday at noon is when the monthly orders are usually submitted. A reminder email will usually be sent out.

Important notes:

- Scrip orders are usually due on the second to last Friday of each month. Orders are due by 12:00 pm on that date. Be sure to have your order submitted before then. A reminder email will usually be sent out.
- Prior to any orders being processed or your scrip account being activated by MYHA, the MYHA Scrip Program Agreement must be signed.
- Scrip orders will be delivered or mailed to you.
- All orders will be online with www.shopwithscrip.com. PrestoPay will charge you a fee of \$0.15 every time you order, regardless of order size or type. Credit card orders will charge a % of the total for each order.
- Accumulated rebates mustn't be used for hockey fees/fundraising requirements. Charitable contributions can be made to MYHA and will provide you with an acknowledgement of your gift for tax purposes.
- A cash-out of your rebates can also be requested by contacting the MYHA Scrip Coordinator.
- If your rebate earned is larger than your MYHA registration fees/fundraising requirements, your remaining rebate will roll over for future registration fees/fundraising requirements unless a charitable contribution or cash-out option has been requested.
