

DH Football Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Does the school district pay for the football program?

A: No. The district does provide some assistance, but the 12th Man Club pays over 80% of the football program expenses through fundraising efforts like the Player Contribution program.

Q: Does DH Football receive the proceeds from home game ticket sales?

A: Unfortunately, no we do not receive revenue from the gate.

Q: What is the requested contribution amount for 2017?

A: \$950. All other programs request a contribution, and ours is the lowest in Southern Orange County.

Q: Is my contribution tax deductible?

A: Possibly! The 12th Man is a registered 501 (c) 3 charity and will provide you with the appropriate donation forms to present to your tax specialist.

Q: Is the contribution due in July?

A: No. We would appreciate contributions be made as soon as possible, but ask all player contributions be made by October.

Q: Can I pay by Credit Card?

A: YES. We can accept all forms of payment: Cash, Check and Credit Cards. If paying by Credit Card, you can do so through the DHFootball.com website under the PLAYERS tab or at one of our designated team events such as Jersey Night on Aug 18th. One note, if paying by Credit Card there are additional fees added by our credit card vendors for processing and handling. Paying by cash or check does not require additional processing fees or charges. Please make checks out to: **12TH MAN CLUB**

Q: Can I break-up the payments over time?

A: YES. If you elect to break-up the contribution you can do so in 12 payments starting in the month of your choice. This makes the monthly payment \$79 each month.
