Accepted teams and schedules will come out

Answer: ALWAYS contact your manager, they will have all the up to date information. As we draw nearer to the tournament fewer phone calls and emails means more time for us to prepare for the tournament.

When answering or creating an email, what information do I need to include?

Answer: Always include **team name, gender and age group** you are playing in. If you know the flight you would want to include that also.

Where do I find the team manager contact checklist

Answer: On the PYSA tournament page in the right column. All you need to do is click on it and it will pop up. Print it and use the check boxes to help you remember what you need to do.

I am a North Texas team how do I know what I need to submit.

Answer: Number 1 on the team manager checklist

I am an out of town team what do I need to submit

Answer: Number 2 on the checklist should give you all the information you need.

Who is eligible to qualify as a travel team?

Answer: Any team that is from out of town and staying in a tournament hotel. Any team that is playing in the tournament is required to stay in an approved hotel. <http://ebdplanners.com/event/plano-youth-soccer-association-labor-day-invitational/> or contact Sheila Honore, Events By Design, (972) 965-1238, sheila.honore@ebdplanners.com. Who is eligible to use the online check in?

Answer: Everybody is eligible to participate in online check in. BUT it must be complete by August 17 per the instructions contained in the travel team's information contained in number 2 on the manager's checklist. Local teams can find the information in the North Texas Soccer Association section, they will also need to complete the check in process by August 17. If your information is incomplete you will have to go through the regular tournament check-in contained at the bottom of the checklist, there will be no exceptions.

I am a US Club member what do I need to do?

Answer: Please check number 3 on The Team Manager Contact Checklist.

What is the Plano Labor Day mailing address?

Answer: Plano Labor Day Tournament, 221 West Parker Road Suite 480, Plano, TX 75023

How do I know how many players and guest players I can have?

Answer: That information is contained in the General Tournament Information; the left hand column, below the deadline date, on the tournament web page, it will also tell you the number of guest players allowed, player format etc.

How many minutes will our game be?

Answer: Under the 2016 Tournament Rules listed in the right hand column under Tournament Information. All rules are listed there including Game Information.

How do I see the coaches who are participating?

Answer: Click on the College Coaches Tournament Registration on the tournament page then click on the College Coaches tab

Do you allow professional photographers at the tournament?

Answer: No we don't, we require all vendors to have security clearances for the safety of our players and their families; because of the large number of requests and security issues we are not permitting professional photographers.

Do you allow pets?

Answer: NO, as much as we know you love your pets there are those who don't, are allergic, have been bitten etc.

Can I park an RV and picnic at the fields?

Answer: Unfortunately no as we are pressed for parking at most of our complexes

How do I fill out the medical release form.

Answer: Just type in the required information. When you click on the "click here to enter text" it will turn blue and you just type your name in

What colors do I wear as home team?

Answer: The home team is always in white but required to change if there is a color conflict

How can I see the scores?

Answer: They will be posted on line, if there is a problem with the score the manager or coach should send an email to pld.pysa@gmail.com

Do I really need 6 blue cards and what do I do with them?

Answer: Yes, if you make it through the final game you will need to turn in to the complex tent to have the scores recorded. Both teams should sign off on the score in the space provided.

What do I do with my game report?

Answer: You will give the game report filled out with game time, field, etc. to the referee. The referee will record the game score and cards and return to tournament officials.

What if I forgot to get my game report stamped with the official tournament stamp and accidentally missed the check-in time?

Answer: The tournament encourages everyone to follow the proper procedure for registering before the first game. Russell Creek South is the tournament headquarters and can help resolve your concerns.

What are the field sizes and rules for 9v9 U9 and U10

U9 & U10- Field size 50x80- There is no heading.

What will U11 and U12 look like?

Answer: U11 and U12 will play on a 50X80 field. U 11 may not head the ball, however, U12 will be allowed to head. Both U11 and U12 can punt.
