Old Business: Acceptance of April and May minutes. All approved

New Business:

1. State Meeting update:
  - a. State venues- PDC will be in CDA. HS tournament in Idaho Falls. High School teams want us to come to their tournaments, but we are hoping for reciprocation. State Tourney Midget & Girls and Bantam- NO A&B teams- in Boise. Each association can send 2 teams.
  - b. Background Checks- the rate is rising. The background checks need to be made every two years, not three.
  - c. Level 4 clinic Sept 12-14—if we can get 75 people from the area, then we can host.
  - d. Safe Sport- each adult that will be in contact with a player must do safe sport module. Safe Sport needs to be completed before Nov 30<sup>th</sup>. All coaches and managers should begin their Safe Sport now to ensure it is done by Nov. 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - e. Birth cert.- no rosters signed without birth certificates.

**ITEM**

  - a. Section 4.0 4.1 (c) (i)  
In the event of a conflict between Varsity High School games, bantam travel games, and Girls U19-U14 travel games and practices - bantam travel and girls travel will take priority with an understanding between the coaches and directors involved.

(ii) All registered IFYHA players playing in 2 different house divisions must sign a contract at the beginning of the season outlining their priorities. If players do not live up to these priorities they will become ineligible for all travel and high school varsity venues for the remainder of the IFYHA season.

(iii) Bantam second year freshman and girl second year freshman that are playing Midget/HS must also commit to their bantam house and girls house schedule.
