MHOA was established in 1984 to provide a forum to create better communication and understanding between officials, coaches, players, hockey associations, and communities within the state of Minnesota. MHOA also was created for the purpose of improving and training hockey officials, to insure uniformity of rules interpretation and to maintain the highest standards of officiating in the state of Minnesota. MHOA is made up of all USA Hockey officials that are completely registered and have paid the current years dues. There is a Board of Directors, which consists of one appointed representative, supervisor of official, from each district as well as a President, two Vice Presidents, Treasurer, and Secretary with elections held for most board positions each spring at the general membership meeting. Each official that officiates USA Hockey sanctioned games in the state of Minnesota is required to belong to MHOA according to the Minnesota Hockey by-laws.
