Personnel Report	Coaches Meeting- November 9, 2015	<p><b><u>Coaches Forms:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Josh Jungling relays back from the ARAA board meeting that they are starting to pay more for coaches than volunteering. Need to be careful with how we fill the forms; employees vs subcontractors.</li> <li>• Coaches will be using a 1099. We will have a list of tournaments for the coaches to go to and they will sign off on that. They will also need to sign the 1099 upfront and can't get paid until they sign this form.</li> <li>• Expectations for the events: around 29 practices—will attend all, discussed how many local tournaments are they expected to attend: qualifiers and open. Will need to wait until the schedule is finalized to determine which ones and how many within 20 miles. Highly recommend the coaches to attend Gopher Nationals.
