

How do my players register?

Now that you're registered as a Captain, your players can register by following the below steps. 1/22/2018



- **Step 1: Navigate to www.pgajrleague.com** and click on 'Register' at the top of the page
- **Step 2: Enter in the search parameters to find the facility they would like to register at.**
 - » A zip code or keyword search can be performed
 - » Once the facility is found, click the green "Register" button

- **Step 3: Login to your SportsEngine account**
 - » Login to your existing SportsEngine account, or click the "Create an Account" button if you do not have an account
- **Step 4: Fill out the registration form**
 - » Complete the form and make an online payment to complete your registration. Once completed, you'll arrive at a receipt screen. A receipt will also be mailed to the account email used when registering
