Player's and Coach's Code of Ethics

I hereby pledge to provide a positive attitude and be responsible for my participation in High School Rugby by following this Code of Ethics:

2. I will attend every practice and game that is reasonably possible and notify my coach if I cannot.

Parent's Code of Conduct
