OPENING:

The Parkland Football Booster Club meeting started at 7:08PM.

PRESENT

There were 4 board members, 4 members and Coach Moncman in attendance

A. **READING AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The minutes from the October 11, 2016 meeting were approved.

B. **OFFICER'S REPORTS**

1. **President's Report:**

- Brody was home for the weekend and is doing well; hoping to be home for the holidays
- Bylaws – to remain on agenda until reviewed (during off-season)

2. **Vice President's Report:**

- Received the invoice from TN Printing for the program books and was less than last year's bill due to ordering less program books this year
- They would like to do the program book again next year and offered to do the entire book in color printing – will forward email to Erin for future reference.

3. **Treasurer's Report:**

- Beginning balance is \$27,713.63
- Ending balance is \$25,006.20
- Outstanding invoices that need to be paid – Hudl and pierogies
- Fundraising income is down considerably from last year – down about \$15,000 for Trojan Challenge, Lottery Calendar down a bit, hoagie fundraisers are better
- Needs to deposit the money from the concession stand

C. **COACH'S REPORT**

- Will provide a list of amounts for the coaches stipends
- Boys are signed up to help with the pancake breakfast (about 45 of them); approximate cost for the pancake breakfast is about \$150 without the cost of the orange juice and coffee (we can get coffee from the concession stand); setup a table at two gates on Friday night to sell tickets – 2 parents to man the gate (Erin and another parent with AJ)
- Coach Moncman mentioned he would also do a lift-a-thon
- If we win on Friday night it will either be at J Birney Crum or BASD
- 3 players made all league – Patrick Ferry, DJ Hohman and Jahan Worth; Jahan Worth also was named Defensive MVP

D. **SPECIAL ORDERS**

- Middle School party held; Freshman banquet coming up on 11/20 – team parents sent home the reservation form and it was also emailed to the parents

- Lottery Ticket Calendar update – 419 tickets sold out of 1000
- Schaf Video – paid for Freshman and JV games for the season; will need to wait for the invoice for the Varsity games which he will send to the high school and then we'll pay for the invoice; as far as a highlight video – we need to look at the invoice
- Varsity/JV banquet – Sunday, February 19 at the American Club of Copley; we will do the same gifts for sophomores (duffle bags) and juniors (sweatshirts with name and position); Shelley to send out an email asking for volunteers for the committee to start planning; come back to the December meeting with an approximate cost per person of how much it will cost for each athlete/parent – discussion was held and decided to keep prices the same for players/parents/guests as last year
- Officer nominations for 2017 – send out a detailed email with the duties for each position

E. **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

- Senior Night – the rain held off just in time to get the players/parents announced on the field; the dinner was great – thank you to Howie for supplying the tent; the parents enjoyed the evening

F. **GENERAL ORDER**

- Fundraisers:
 - Lottery calendar update – Maryann Puia – see above
 - Pancake/Sausage update – Shelley; sold 28 tickets so far – event is advertised on FB, announcements made at last week's game, also on the TV's in the school – will go ahead with the fundraiser – put one person at each gate to sell tickets at Friday night's game
- Powerlifting Meet – Saturday, February 25; concession stand area reserved and Coach Steiner has the gym reserved; start getting sponsors and planning for the event; invite Coach Steiner to the December meeting
