Tryouts/Evaluations: NO TRYOUTS UNLESS NEEDED

Two separate checks made payable to North Branch Area Traveling Baseball Association (NBATBA), waiver of liability and code of conduct forms will be required to have your child participate in the program:

- 1) \$275 Pre-Registration Fee or \$300 if received after February 16th.
- 2) \$100 Volunteer Check per Family (If your family completes the required credits, the check will be shredded. If your family does not complete the required volunteer credits by June 30th, 2019, your check will be cashed by the association.)

Please ensure that these checks are included with your registration or it will be considered after the pre-registration date. Cash will not be accepted. There are no exceptions for the two checks per player guideline. This is due to volunteer checks possibly being shredded, based on requirements volunteer credits. Any check cashed by the association, for any reason, that is returned due to cancellation and/or insufficient funds will be turned over to a collection agency to recover the fees and any associated expenses by the collection agency. By registering your child and making payment to the association, based on the requirements listed, you agree to any all terms of the association.

Requests for specific coaches will not be accepted. Evaluators and coaches will be selecting players/teams to guarantee that North Branch will have competitive teams. Players need board approval to play up. Board approval does not guarantee a spot on the team and depends on try outs. The board reserves the right to adjust level of play decisions at any time based on registration numbers, finalizing team rosters, or other applicable factors.

Traveling Baseball involves the following:

Tryouts may be required.

Regular season tournaments will be offered on a team basis and be paid for by the player/parents (one tournament will be selected and paid for by the association).

State Tournament: qualification required.

Out of State Tournaments will be available upon team discretion.

Approximately a 16 game season as well as a practice schedule. Each team will participate in at least 1 weekend tournament.

There may be additional costs as the season progresses for tournaments if additional tournaments are played by each age level beyond the one tournament paid by the association.

Fundraising opportunities will be available and may be required based on association determination. Fundraising funds not used during your North Branch Area Traveling Baseball participation are non-transferable and non-refundable.

Bat Standards: Please note that the Gopher State Baseball league has bat standards for all age levels. If you choose to purchase a bat for your child, please visit www.myas.org for specific requirements.

Player Registration/Eligibility:

Players in their respective age groups must not reach the next age before May 1 at 12:01am. A player may request to the board to play up from their designated age division, but they may not play down. For example, a 10 year old may play in the 11 year old division, but a 12 year old may NOT play in the 11 year old division. Player move ups will not be considered until after registration and player try outs if applicable. The board reserves the right to review and determine all requests independently. Any player requesting to play up an age level will be evaluated during try-outs at that age level. All final decisions are by the board.

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North Branch Area Traveling Baseball Association Waiver of Liability, Release

Assumption of Risk & Indemnity Agreement

It is the purpose of this agreement to exempt, waive and relieve releases from liability for personal injury, property damage, and wrongful death, including if caused by negligence, including the negligence, if any, of releases. "Releases" include North Branch Area Traveling Baseball Association its affiliates, event hosts, other participants, coaches, officials, sponsors, advertisers and each of them, their officials, directors, agents and employees.

For and in consideration of the undersigned participant's registration with North Branch Area Traveling Baseball Association, its affiliates(referred to together as NBATBA) and being allowed to participate in NBATBA events and member team activities, participant (and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) participant, if applicable) waive, release and relinquish any and all claims for liability and cause(s) of action, including for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death occurring to participant, arising out of participation in NBATBA events, member team activities, the sport, and/or activities incidental thereto. Whenever or however they occur and for such period said activities may continue, and by this agreement any such claims, rights, and causes of action that participant (and participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) may have and hereby waived, released and relinquished, and participant (parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) does (do) so on behalf of my/our and participants heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

Participant (and participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge, understand and assume all risks relating to sports and any member team activities, and understand that sports and member team activities involve risks to participant's person including bodily injury, partial or total disability, paralysis and death, and damages which may arise there from and that have full knowledge of said risks. These risks and dangers may be caused by the negligence of the participant or the negligence of others, including the "releases" identified below. These risks and dangers include, but are not limited to, those arising from participating with bigger, faster and stronger participants, and these risks and dangers will increase if participant participates in sports and member team activities in an age group above that which participant would normally participate in. I/We further acknowledge that there may be risks and dangers not known to us or not reasonably foreseeable at this time. Participant (and participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledges, understand and agree that all of the risks and dangers described throughout this agreement, including those caused by the negligence of participant and/or others, are included within the waiver, release and relinquishment described in the preceding paragraph. I/We agree to abide by and be bound under the rules of NBATBA, including the By-laws of the corporation as currently published. Copies are available to NBATBA members upon written request.

Participant (and participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge, understand and assume the risks, if any, arising from the conditions and related premises and acknowledge and understand that included within the scope of this waiver and release is any cause of action (including any cause of action based on negligence) arising from the performance, or failure to perform, maintenance, inspection, supervision or control of said areas and for the failure to warn of dangerous conditions existing at said areas, for negligence selection of certain releases, or negligent supervision or instruction by releases.

Participant (and participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) agree if any claim for participant's personal injury or wrongful death is commenced against releases, he/she shall defend, indemnify and save harmless releases from any and all claims or causes of action by whomever or wherever made or presented for participant's personal injuries, property damage or wrongful death.

Participant (and participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s), if applicable) acknowledge that they have been provided and have read the above paragraphs and have not relied upon any representations of releases, that they are fully advised of the potential dangers of sports and understand these waivers and releases are necessary to allow amateur sports to exist in its present form. Significant exclusions may apply to NBATBA insurance policies which could affect any coverage. For example, there is no liability coverage for claims of one player against another player.

- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement of my child his teammates and coaching staff while participating in the North Branch Traveling Association.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating respect and positive support of all players, coaches and officials at every game, practice or other North Branch Traveling Baseball Association sports activity.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child and the team ahead of any personal desire to win.
- I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child to provide a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I understand that Traveling Baseball is a progressively competitive sport and equal playing time is not guaranteed.
- I will demand a drug, alcohol and tobacco-free environment for my child and agree to assist by refraining from their use at all North Branch Traveling Association sporting events.
- I will remember that youth sports activities are for the children and not the adults. I will do my best to make youth sporting activities fun for my child.
- I will encourage my child to treat their teammates, other players, coaches, officials and fans with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability. I will set an example by doing so myself.
- I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience within my personal constraints by assisting with coaching or officiating, performing maintenance, or whatever I am capable of doing, as well as being a respectful and sportsman-like fan and spectator,
- I will refrain from using rude, profane, or abusive language and from the demonstration of actions or gestures that are threatening, abusive, or unsportsmanlike in nature.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field. If I have a concern or question, I will take time later to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place. This will include adhering to the 24 hour suggestion made for a cool down period.
- I will abide by all rules and regulations of the North Branch Traveling Association as it pertains to fields & equipment.
- I understand that the administration of this code is the responsibility of the North Branch Traveling Baseball Association Board of Directors and I agree this code and its administration is a condition of my child's participation in the North Branch Traveling Baseball Association program.
- I understand that a violation of this code may result in the suspension or termination of my participation in the North Branch Traveling Baseball Association.
