

## **Marquette Junior Hockey COVID 19 protocol based on recommendations from the Marquette Health Department and MAHA**

- If a player has signs of illness, they will not be able to participate. They will be recommended to quarantine for 14 days.
- May resume MJH sponsored events with a negative COVID test result. (Example: if a player went home with a temperature and sore throat but had strep. They may come back based on the doctor's recommendations.)
- If the player is tested and is COVID positive, the Health Department gets the information directly from the clinic that provided the test. The Health Department gives the family the plan for their family to follow.
- If a case is reported to any team, and/or association liaison, it should immediately be reported to all applicable parties including the Director of Hockey Operations. The DOHO will report to the Michigan Amateur Hockey Association (MAHA).
- The Health Department will do a contact investigation based on where the family has been and who is considered a close contact.
- Families need to give permission to the Health Department to talk to Marquette Junior Hockey to give personal information regarding the test results and plan. Marquette Junior Hockey will share any information requested by the Health Department to help in contact tracing.
- The Health Department would report to the MJH DOHO that a person tested positive in our organization. The Health Department would then reach out all of the people that are considered a close contact and give them their family plan to follow (quarantine, isolate, test, etc.)
- Marquette Jr. Hockey will not share the names of individuals that test positive for COVID with members of the organization.
