Eric Anderson: Introductions of Board members

- Introduced 12 voting Board members
- Introduced non-voting members

Eric Anderson: Website and Social Media

- New website, <u>www.oregonsc.com</u>, launched in August 2016 using Sports Engine
- Easier email addresses for Board members, don't have to use personal accounts
- Traffic has increased by an average of 15% each month
- Added Twitter (@OregonSC78) and Instagram (OregonSC78) accounts. Also YouTube channel available with many footskill videos

Eric Anderson: Oregon Soccer Fall Fury

- Club's largest fundraiser
- Numbers down from previous years due to lack of fields available for U11 and older.
- Dates for 2017: Sept 15-17
- Looking for assistant tournament director and scheduler(s)

Eric Anderson: Spring 2017

- Competitive coaching assignments. Only a few changes noted.
- Fields: More problems occur in the spring with fields due to the rain. Opening of the fields will come from the school district. Hoping they will open by April 3 when practice is

supposed to begin. If fields close for the day, an email will go out to everyone who is signed up through Sports Engine. School are also contacted prior to 2 p.m. whenever possible. Important to stay off fields when they are closed and to stay out of the goal boxes.

- MAYSA schedules were finalized on Friday, March 17. Many of the concerns that were brought up about league placements during the fall season were addressed by MAYSA when putting together the leagues for spring.
- Practices for Competitive and Academy start April 3 and gym time is reserved if necessary
- MAYSA and U7/8 leagues first games are April 22-23. 4K Kickers/Rookie League scheduled to start April 9.
- Two spring tournaments are scheduled for most Competitive teams: Rush Wisconsin Spring Classic in Wisconsin Dells/Mauston and MC United Mountain Bay Cup in Wausau, All information is on the club website.
- No practices Memorial Day or the Friday before.
- June 11 is official last day of MAYSA season, but teams can play until June 30.

Eric Anderson: Training Opportunities this Spring and Summer

- Optimum Technique with Kevin Gowrie has Spring Break Camp March 27-31
- Under-7/8 Pre-Academy with Peter Wright on Sunday evenings
- Challenger PDP for U10 and under with Peter Wright
- Bob Bradbury will run weekly goalkeeper sessions, likely on Sunday evenings.
- Four summer camps in Oregon: Challenger Sports (TetraBrazil in June and British Camp in July) and Optimum Technique in July. Also, Mark Diercks' Showtime camp.

Eric Anderson: Looking Ahead

- Uniforms: Looking into other options, but decided to remain with Stefans. New for Competitive - uniforms run in two-year cycles, our current Competitive uniform style is being retired. In response to several requests, also adding a new style of uniform for Academy teams, different from Competitive and Recreational. Still unsure on how we will handle Recreational uniforms.
