National Travel Teams

Purple Teams

National Purple teams are designed for players that will compete at the highest possible level. These players have aspirations of continuing their post club playing career at the collegiate level.

Purple teams will compete at a minimum in the three (3) day Southern California Junior National Qualifier held at Las Vegas, NV and an end of the season National Championship event. The default end of the season tournament will be the AAU National Championships in Orlando, FL. Should a team earn a bid to USAV National Championships, the club will decide whether the team will participate at USAV or AAU Nationals. Most purple teams will travel to at least one additional out of state national qualifier/showcase tournament.

Purple teams will place team goals before all else and are managed with performance-based playtime standard. Players are expected to support the team's goals before any personal agendas.

Black Teams

National Black teams are designed for players with aspirations of competing at a high club level. Black team athletes are also dedicated and passionate, and interested in competing for their High School program. Some of these athletes are also potentially interested in continuing their post club playing career at the collegiate level.

Black teams will compete at a minimum in the three (3) day Southern California Junior National Qualifier held at Las Vegas, NV and an end of the season National Championship event. The default end of the season tournament will be the AAU National Championships in Orlando, FL. Should a team earn a bid to USAV National Championships, the club will decide whether the team will participate at USAV or AAU Nationals. Some of our black teams will travel to at least one additional out of state national qualifier/showcase tournament.

Black teams will place team goals before all else and are managed with performance-based playtime standard. Players are expected to support the team's goals before any personal agendas.

Purple/Black teams begin their practice schedule the first week of December (15U-18U) and first week of November (14U and younger), and finish the season in the final week of June or first week of July, depending on the end of season tournament.

Limited Travel Teams

Gray Teams

Athletes are passionate about the sport, work hard to improve, and wish to continue to play through their Junior High and High School years without the time and financial commitment required from our National Travel Team Program. Gray athletes have aspirations of playing for their High School programs and some even want to continue playing in college. Our Gray teams balance playtime in a manner that supports the development of each one of our players, while trying to maintain a high competitive level.

Gray teams will compete at a minimum in the three (3) day Southern California Junior National Qualifier held at Las Vegas, NV and at the SCVA Summer Soiree held in Anaheim. Gray teams begin their practice schedule the first week of December (15U-18U) and first week of November (14U and younger), and finish the season on July 2nd (Summer Soiree).

Regional Teams

White Teams

Athletes are passionate about volleyball and want to continue to play through their Junior High and High School years, but without the time and financial commitment required from our National/Limited Travel Team Programs. Our White teams manage playtime in a manner that supports the development of each one of our players.

White Teams will compete in the SCVA regional tournaments which consist of eight (8) one day tournaments. The practice schedule begins the first week of December (15U-18U) and first week of November (14U and younger), and the season will end on the last week of May or first week of June, depending on the SCVA final tournament date.
