Exhibitions/Competitions

Each year, El Paso Figure Skating Club holds several exhibitions. We also hold an in-house competition as well as travel to several other competitions throughout the United States.

Private Lessons - Private lessons can be added to group lessons at any time. They are great to help a skater who would like to move along a bit faster, would like to compete, or just needs some extra one on one attention. Coaching rates typically range from \$15 to \$25 for a 30- minute lesson, plus a \$10.00 ice fee. Freestyle Sessions

El Paso Figure Skating Club has private ice during the week where skaters can practice their routines with music, and jumps/spins/spirals. Skaters enrolled in the Home School Program are allowed to practice during this ice time for the club member rate of \$10 per hour.

Dress Code

- ❖ Single-blade hockey or figure skates.
- ❖ Comfortable, loose warm clothing. NO jeans. Jackets and gloves are highly recommended. No ankle socks.
- ❖ It is highly recommended children 5 and under wear a helmet. Bicycle helmets or hockey helmets are acceptable.

The Home School Program



- ❖ Specially geared toward Home School skaters ages 5 and up.
- ❖ This program promotes fitness. Skaters will learn new skills and learn about skating in a fun environment. All classes are group lessons.
- ❖ Skaters are tested to determine skill mastery and progression to the next level. Certificates are awarded to all skaters. Patches will be given to all skaters who pass each skating level test.
- ❖ **\$120 per month, Early Registration Fee (Before September 29): \$100**
- ❖ 5 minute off-ice/on ice warm up. 45 minute on ice lesson. 10 min practice time.
- ❖ Classes are held Tuesday and Thursday 3 p.m. - 4 p.m.
- ❖ You can register in person at one of our registration dates or the day of the class.
